# Day 1

# Thursday 20th June

Weather: Stansted, Overcast and rain. Ljubljana; fine, hot and sunny

Seven tour participants met Paul and Kerrie at the departures gate at Stansted Airport for the flight to Ljubljana. Upon our arrival, we completed immigration formalities and collected our luggage, before making our way to the arrivals hall, where we met up with Steph, the final member of the group, and Milan and his son Miro, our divers for the week. With luggage loaded, we set off travelling towards Kranj, before joining the motoway northwest to the exit for Bled. Passing through the town we soon had spectacular views of Lake Bled and the imposing Castle Bled, perched some 130m above the lake on the north shore. Continuing on, the road ran beside the Sava Bohinjka River. Before long, we passed through the small town of Bohinjska Bistrica and the villages of Savica and Polje, before arriving in Ribcev Laz, situated at the eastern end of the beautiful Lake Bohinj, and the Alpinum Hotel Jezero, our base for the duration of the tour. Having settled into our rooms, we met in reception, where Kerrie and Paul outlined some of the program for the week. This was followed by dinner.

Day 2 Friday 21st June

Weather: Fine, hot and sunny

After breakfast, we met with our local guide, Marija, before embarking on our first full day. Our objective was to walk the path along the north side of Lake Bohinj. This route would take us through natural woodland, pastures and planted woodland of Fagus sylvatica (Beech) and Picea abies (Norway Spruce). Before setting off Marija gave us an explanation of the vegetation types and the geology, in order to give a picture of how the area developed and how it had been influenced humans. We began making our way through natural forest, comprised of Fagus sylvatica (Beech), Ostrya carpinifolia (Hop Hornbeam), Corylus avellana (Hazel), Fraxinus excelsior (Ash) and Juniperus communis subsp. communis (Common Juniper). Early finds included Neottia ovata (Twayblade), Salvia pratensis (Meadow Clary), Allium vineale (Crow Garlic), Thalictrum aquilegifolium (Great Meadow Rue) and Clematis recta (Erect Clematis). Insects were also beginning to make an appearance. These included three different Chafers, Cetonia aurata (Rose Chafer), Phyllopertha horticola (Garden Chafer) and Oxythyrea funesta (a Chafer). Butterflies were also appearing. Duke of Burgundy Fritillary, Small White and Pearly Heath were all recorded.

The bird life was not particularly obvious, but European Greenfinch, Common Chaffinch and European Robin were all heard. We took lunch where a stream emptied into the lake, and two members of the group elected to go for a swim, to cool off. Meanwhile Chequered Skipper, Wood White, Holly Blue, and Large Skipper butterflies were added. Moving on, we found Cephalanthera damasonium (White Helleborine), Epipactis atrorubens (Dark Red Helleborine), Frangula alnus (Alder Buckthorn), Rhamnus saxatilis (Rock Buckthorn), Petrorhagia saxifraga (Tunic Flower) and Hacquetia epipactis (Hacquetia). After crossing a boulder filled dry river bed, we added Maianthemum bifolia (May Lily), Astrantia carniolica (Carnic Masterwort), Cirsium erisithales (Yellow Melancholy Thistle) and Silene alpestris (Alpine Catchfly).

We were now closing in on the village of Ukanc, our destination. We ended the day with more exciting finds. Clouded Yellow, Idas Blue and Little Blue butterflies were added, together with *Dianthus sanguineous* (a Pink), *Campanula glomerata* (Clustered Bellflower), *Lunaria redivida* (Perennial Honesty) and *Orobanche gracilis* (Slender Broomrape). However, one memorable moment came where we encountered a 'wall of scent', just before finding a bank of *Dianthus sternbergii* (Sternberg's Pink). From Ukanc, we caught the boat back to the jetty at Ribcev Laz, near our hotel. As we progressed, the guide gave us some historical facts and folklore of the region as we made the fifteen minute journey.

# Day 3

# Saturday 22nd June

Weather: Fine Hot and Sunny. Light rain and thunder later

After breakfast, we left the hotel, and retraced our steps along the lake shore to the open meadows, where the footpath to Stara Fuzina branched off to the right, through a gate into more pasture. Campanula rapunculoides (Creeping Bellflower) and Ranunculus sardous (Hairy Buttercup) were both recorded, and some of the group had views of a Red-backed Shrike. We emerged by the car park at Stara Fuzina, and took the track up the beautiful Korita Mostnice Gorge, passing through forest, past wet rocks and also open areas of scrub and grassy banks. Common Blue, Duke of Burgundy Fritillary and Pearly Heath butterflies were seen and European Robin and Common Chaffinch were heard. Pinguicula alpina (Alpine Butterwort), Genista radiata (Southern Greenweed), Veronica officinalis (Heath Speedwell), Homogyne sylvestrisis (a Purple Coltsfoot), Neottia nidus-avis (Bird's-nest Orchid), Lonicera xylosteum (Fly Honeysuckle) and Gymnadenia conopsea subsp. conopsea (Fragrant Orchid) were all seen before we took a short breather on the rocks by the Mostnica River. Here, we found Veronica lutea (Yellow Paederota) and were entertained by White-throated Dippers dashing up and down the river and apparently feeding young.

Moving on, we emerged from the gorge at Pl. Koca na Vojah, a refugio, where we had lunch of goulash or mushroom soup. After our meal we continued up the gently ascending path, passing *Euonymus verrucosus* (a Spindle Tree), *Ranunculus platanifolius* (a white Buttercup), *Phyteuma nigra* (Black Rampion) and *Symphytum bulbosum* (Tuberous Comfrey). Hay meadows now opened up before us and in the margins we found the beautiful endemic *Lilium carniolicum* (Carnic Lily), together with *Dianthus barbatus* (Sweet William), *Phyteuma ovatum* (Dark Rampion), *Aconitum lycoctonum subsp. vulparia* (Wolf's-bane), *Phyteuma scheuchzeri* (Horned Rampion) and *Geranium phaeum* (Dusky Crane's-bill). In the pasture we also saw Purple-edged Copper, Ringlet, Scotch Argus and Large Skipper butterflies, and overhead four Northern Ravens were circling.

From the pastures, we re-entered the woodland, where the path took us up to the Slape Mostnice (Mostnice Waterfall). From here, we made the descent back to where we had lunch, by a different route, where the minibus was waiting to return us to the hotel in time for dinner. Along the way we found a small stand of *Neotinea ustulata* (Burnt Orchid).

Day 4

Sunday 23rd June

Weather: Warm with High cloud and sunny periods

Today, we boarded the buses at the hotel after breakfast, for the journey to Goreljek, on the Pokljuka plateau, situated northeast of Ribcev Laz. We made our way up through Stara Fuzina and Studor, through Cesnjica, Jereka and Koprivnik, before climbing up to Goreljek, where the buses dropped us off. This is an area of hay meadows, pastures, *Picea abies* (Norway Spruce) plantation forest and peat bog with natural forest.

We started the day walking down a track towards the Sotno Barje peat-bog, passing summer cottages and meadows. Early finds included *Veratrum album subsp. lobelianum* (Green False Helleborine), *Melampyrum sylvaticum* (Wood Cow-wheat), *Homogyne discolor* (a purple Colt's-foot) and *Vaccinium vitis-idaea* (Cowberry). Further on, we added *Moneses uniflora* (One-flowered Wintergreen) and *Maianthemum bifolia* (May Lily) on a track bank by a plantation, which in turn produced a single stem of the locally scarce *Neottia cordata* (Lesser Twayblade) and two small clumps of *Corallorhiza trifida* (Coralroot Orchid). There was also a brief glimpse of a *Sciurus vulgaris* (Red Squirrel). In all, this was a very exciting start to the day.

We now made our way into the peat-bog, where, initially, we added *Pinus mugo* (Dwarf Mountain Pine), *Eriophorum vaginatum* (Hare's-tail Cotton Grass) and *Vaccinium oxycoccus* (Cranberry). The bog was situated in the middle of a natural forest and had a combination of broad-walks and footpaths. At one point we saw a Common Kestrel with prey, before searching a small meadow adjacent to the bog. Here we found *Campanula barbata* (Bearded Bellflower), *Gymnadenia albida* (Small White Orchid) and *Arnica montana* (Arnica).

We took our picnic on the edge of the forest, before continuing on, exploring the road verges and other hillside meadows. The verges produced *Genista germanica* (German Greenweed), *Campanula scheuchzeri* (a Bellflower) and *Ranunculus platanifolius* (a white Buttercup). In the meadows we found large purple patches of *Pedicularis verticillata* (Verticillate Lousewort), together with *Potentilla aurea* (Golden Cinquefoil), *Gymnadenia conopsea subsp. conopsea* (Fragrant Orchid). Insect life was relatively quiet, but we did see the occasional Scotch Argus, and we added two Moths, Silver-ground Carpet and Tawny-barred Angle. We ended the day sampling the delights of a small farm where they produce local cheese. Here we also added Red-backed Shrike, Black Redstart and Northern Raven to the day's bird list, before rejoining the buses for the return journey to our hotel.

Day 5

Monday 24th June

Weather: Intermittent rain and low cloud at altitude, becoming dryer later

We awoke to torrential rain this morning, but Marija still suggested that we go up to one of the highest local areas called Vogel (1535m). The buses picked us up and took us to the cable car, which runs quite steeply up from Ukanc to the refugio station at Vogel.

In the winter, this area is an extensive ski area, with an infrastructure of chairlifts and ski tracks, bordered by limestone outcrops and predominately *Pinus mugo* (Dwarf Mountain Pine) and *Fagus sylvatica* (Beech) forest. During the ascent, we spotted *Laburnum alpinum* (Alpine Laburnum), *Sorbus aucuparia* (Rowan) and *Sambucus racemosus* (Red-berried Elder).

We set off from the Planinska (refugio), finding Arabis glabra (Tower Mustard), Anemone trifolia (Three-leaved Anemone) and Potentilla aurea (Golden Cinquefoil), before we retreated to the café to avoid a very heavy shower. We resumed our explorations, recording Cardamine enneaphyllos (Drooping Bitter-cress), Veronica lutea (Yellow Paederota), Clematis alpina (Alpine Clematis), Dryas octopetala (Mountain Avens) and Geranium sylvaticum (Wood Crane's-bill). The rain had now become quiet steady, so we retired to the Planinska Koca Merjasec refugio for lunch and a chance to dry off a bit.

In the afternoon, some of the group went back down to Ukanc with Kerrie, where Milan was waiting to take them to the Slap Savica waterfall, dropping them some twenty minutes' walk from the falls. This footpath added *Atropa belladonna* (Deadly Nightshade) to the plant list. Meanwhile the remainder of the group stayed up at Vogel, with Paul, and continued their explorations. They moved up higher than the morning's explorations, adding *Soldanella alpina* (Alpine Snowbell), *Salix maldsteiniana* (Waldstein's Willow), *Salix herbacea* (Dwarf Willow), *Thesium alpinum* (Alpine Bastard Toadflax), *Sorbus chamaemespilus* (False Medlar), *Rumex nivalis* (Snow Dock) and, the rapidly going over, *Gentiana clusii* (Clusius's Gentian) and *Gentiana verna* (Spring Gentian). A large snow patch had a good number of *Soldanella alpina* (Alpine Snowbell) around it, also. In addition, they also heard Northern Raven and Alpine Accentor, before retracing their steps to the cable car and the bus back to the hotel for hot showers and warm drinks and dinner

# Day 6 Tuesday 25th June

Weather: Mostly cloudy and warm with sunny periods and some very light rain

We began today by making a short walk to Stara Fuzina, in order to visit a bee keeper, as Honey Bees contribute to the pollination of the wonderful mountain flowers for which the Triglavski Narodni Park is so famous. Along the way we saw *Chelidonium majus* (Greater Celandine), *Cephalanthera rubra* (Red Helleborine) and *Melampyrum pratense* (Common Cow-wheat). We were introduced to Bogdan, who explained the life-cycle of hive bees, and the methods needed to ensure they lived comfortably and produced the end product, honey. He allowed us to sample the different types of honey. Whilst we were there we saw a splendid male Common Redstart and a pair of Spotted Flycatchers.

We now joined our buses to make the journey up to the mountain meadows at Vogar (1054m), high above the Bohinj Lake, on the north side. From the rough car park in the forest, we began to explore. The woodland had *Phyteuma scheuchzeri* (Horned Rampion), *Laburnum alpinum* (Alpine Laburnum) and *Cephalanthera longifolia* (Swordleaved Helleborine). In the first meadow we examined, we found *Gymnadenia conopsea subsp. conopsea* (Fragrant Orchid), *Eriophorum gracile* (Slender Cotton-grass) and *Dactylorhiza fuchsii* (Common Spotted Orchid). Overhead we saw Northern Raven, and in adjacent trees, Eurasian Blackcap was very vocal. The previous day had been insect-free, due to weather. Not so today. Scotch Argus, Grizzled Skipper and Woodland Ringlet butterflies were recorded, as well as Poplar Hawkmoth, Mother Shipton and Silver Y moths.

Moving on through more meadows we added Lilium carniolicum (Carnic Lily), Phyteuma zahlbruckneri, Lilium martagon (Martagon Lily), Neottia ustulata (Burnt Orchid) and Gymnadenia albida (Small White Orchid). Additional butterflies included Black-veined White, Pearl-bordered Fritillary, Heath Fritillary, Purple-shot Copper and Clouded Apollo. After our picnic, we moved on through more forest, which had Paris quadrifolia (Herb Paris), Dryopteris carthusiana (Narrow Buckler Fern) and Pulmonaria officinalis (Common Lungwort), to a splendid viewpoint overlooking the lake and the across the valley to Vogel, where we had been the previous day. The leaves of Gentiana lutea (Great Yellow Gentian) were found, and also Trifolium rubens (Red Trefoil), Vicia sylvatica (Wood vetch) and Aconitum lycoctonum subsp. vulparia (Wolf's-bane).

We ended the day at a meadow with *Traunsteinera globosa* (Round-headed Orchid), *Centaurea montana* (Perennial Cornflower) and a single spike of *Linum viscosum* (Sticky Flax), before taking some refreshments at the adjacent refugio. The final stop of the day came on the journey back to the hotel. We made a stop by some towering cliffs. Here we saw *Primula auricula* (Bear's-ear), although it was well past its best, *Campanula scheuchzeri* and a fabulous show of *Saxifraga crustata* (Encrusted Saxifrage).

# Day 7

# Wednesday 26th June

Weather: Fine, warm and sunny in the morning, persistent rain in the afternoon

Today we had a change of direction. Joining our buses, we drove eastwards to Bohinjska Bistrica, and then we took the road towards Nemski Rovt, before turning onto a forest road, which we followed for about 6 or 7 kilometres. Along the way we saw *Cicerbita alpina* (Alpine Sowthistle) and *Doronicum austriacum* (Austrian Leopard's-bane) and also Common Buzzard and Mistle Thrush. Leaving the vehicles at a footpath, we set off up the steep forested hillside towards the Oroznova Koca refugio. As we went we heard Eurasian Wren, Common Chaffinch and European Robin, and saw Eurasian Blackcap. Plants included *Corydalis cava* (Bulbous Corydalis), *Salix waldsteiniana* (Waldstein's Willow), *Sambucus racemosus* (Red-berried Elder), *Adoxa moschatellina* (Moschatel), *Ribes alpinum* (Mountain Currant), *Lycopodium annotinum* (Interrupted Clubmoss) and *Stellaria nemorum* (Wood Stitchwort). It was not too long before we emerged from the forest at the Oroznova Koca, at 1344m, where we had morning coffee. Growing around the refugio was *Ranunculus lanuginosus* (a Buttercup), *Scorzonera purpurea subsp. rosea* (a Viper's-grass) and *Rumex alpinus* (Monk's Rhubarb).

From the refugio, the path continued upwards to Crna Prst [pronounced Chur-nap-ur] at 1844m. Along the path there were a number of signs naming many of the plants, as a botanical route. Several members of the group chose to continue on upwards with Marija and Paul, with the prospect of seeing some of the high alpine species above the tree-line. The other group members, with Kerrie, selected to concentrate on the botanical trail at the lower level. The lower section of the path had *Galium odoratum* (Woodruff), *Pleurospermum austriacum* (Pleurospermum), the beautiful *Anemone narcissiflora* (Narcissus-flowered Anemone), *Saxifraga crustata* (Encrusted Saxifrage), *Hacquetia epipactis* (Hacquetia) *Polystichum lonchitis* (Holly Fern), *Actaea spicata* (Baneberry), *Lonicera caerulea* (Blue-berried Honeysuckle) and *Valeriana tripteris* (Three-leaved valerian).

After stopping to eat our picnic, Paul's group continued upwards, emerging from the trees to a large snow-patch, the margins of which had a good number of *Soldanella alpina* (Alpine Snowbell) growing around the margins. Adjacent boulders had *Primula auricula* (Bear's-ear Primrose), *Saxifraga hostii* (Host's Saxifrage) and *Saxifraga caesia* (Blue Saxifrage).

Further up the path, *Pulsatilla alpina* (Alpine Pasque Flower), *Primula elatior* (Oxlip), *Gentiana verna* (Spring Gentian) were in profusion and another rock had a small colony of *Ranunculus traunfellneri* (an Alpine Buttercup). Alpine Accentor was heard calling, but failed to show itself, and Northern Wall Brown Butterfly was added to the list. Just below the top of Crna Prst, the rain began to fall, so it was felt that we would begin to descend to the refugio and re-join the rest of the party to descend back to the forest road. On the way down, we found two of the normally nocturnal *Salamandra atra* (Alpine Salamander). At the bottom of the path, our vehicles were waiting to return us to the hotel for dinner.

# Day 8

# **Thursday 27th June**

Weather: Cloudy, but warm with sunny periods

Our final day in Slovenia began with a leisurely breakfast, and time for packing, and a visit to the church, before we set off for the town of Bled, northeast of Ribcev Laz. We stopped at the western end of Lake Bled, and walked up through the forest to the viewpoint at Ojstrica. Along the way we found Hepatica nobilis (Hepatica), Cirsium erisithales (Yellow Melancholy Thistle), Ostrya carpinifolia (Hop Hornbeam) and Cardamine enneaphyllos (Drooping Bitter-cress). The rocky viewpoint gave a splendid vista right across Lake Bled to the town, with clear views of Blejski Otok (Bled Island) and Bled Castle. Exploration of the rocky summit yielded Teucrium chamaedrys (Wall Germander), Sedum album (White Stonecrop), Inula ensifolia and Teucrium montana (Mountain Germander).

We now moved to the center of Bled, where we had some free time to enjoy the lake and eat our picnic. The Lake had Mallard and Mute Swan, and there was also Common House Martin, Spotted Flycatcher and European Goldfinch. It was now time to re-join the vehicles for the journey back to Ljubijana Airport for our flight back to Stansted...
