Starry Solomon's-Seal is very easy to grow. It is rhizomatous and spreads readily in many sun and soil situations, between 1-2' per year. Attractive leaves, flowers and green berries with maroon stripes that eventually turn bright red give the plant 3-season interest. Narrower leaves and spike-like rather than feathery white flowers differentiate it from Solomon's-Seal (Maianthemum racemosa/Smilacina racemosa).



Sweeping Sedge

This sedge grows in moist habitats, including soggy woodlands, wetland margins, and vernal ponds. Like other wetland *Carex* species, brome-like sedge is a host plant for a number of native butterflies, moths and several species of skipper. The seeds are attractive to birds.

Virginia Wild Rye

ELYMUS
VIRGINICUS

Part Shade Perennial



Virginia wild rye, is native to a variety of habitats including bottomland forests, upland prairies, glades, stream banks, pastures, fields, etc. After bloom, the mature flowering spikes continue to provide ornamental interest as they gracefully nod and sway in the wind throughout summer and early autumn. Foliage and seed spikes turn tan in fall.



Dark Green Bulrush

Common bulrush is native to moist meadows, bogs, stream/river/lake margins, sloughs, roadside ditches and wet depressions. Culms are topped in late spring with dark green spikelets that are clustered into spherical heads. Spikelets mature to brown by mid-summer and remain attractive well into fall.

Just like other Coneflowers, this will bloom nearly all summer long, all the way up to frost.

This is the perfect companion to ‘Primal Scream’, matching its spider-like look.

'Autumn Frost' is a sport of the 2010 AHGA Hosta of the Year, 'First Frost', which in turn is a sport of the champion of blue hostas, 'Halcyon'. It is a showier version of 'First Frost', displaying extra wide margins.

The leaves emerge frosty blue with a bright yellow margin that lightens to creamy white during the summer. It forms a medium sized mound topped with light lavender flowers in mid to late summer.

There are hostas, and then there's '**Etched Glass**'-bringing style and refinement to the hosta garden. This sport of 'Stained Glass' has wider margins and thicker leaves than the parent. Very wide, dark green margins contrast with a bright, brilliant yellow center. Between the margin and the centers is a light green pattern. Margins have puckering when the plant is mature. Very large and fragrant, near-white flowers appear in late summer.

'Peter Cottontail' has a look that's reminiscent of Baby's Breath, with large, ivory white flowers that are produced over a low, mounding habit of green foliage. The flower clusters on this perennial are more singular and well-spaced, great for adding texture to the garden! This perennial has larger individual flowers and a more polished habit. Although it is named after a fictional rabbit, 'Peter Cottontail', it is mostly unbothered by both deer and rabbits.



Summer Peek-a-Boo Globe Lily

Discovered as a sport of 'Summer Beauty', this shorter selection presents its lavender pink, spherical blooms just at the top of its green, upright, strappy foliage. It has perfect presentation in containers and is a great choice for gardeners looking for pollinator-friendly, low water use plants.



Pretty Lady Emily Anemone

'Pretty Lady Emily' is a compact windflower which typically grows to only 16" tall. It features double, 2", light pink flowers and showy yellow center stamens. Flowers bloom on wiry-but-graceful, upright, branching stems rising from an attractive foliage mound of trifoliate dark green leaves (to 3" long) with toothed margins.



Corbett Wild Columbine

A profuse show of butter-yellow, lantern-shaped flowers from April to May. Its short stature, delicate color and mid-spring bloom time make it an ideal companion for spring bulbs! It was spotted by Lawrence Clemens who asked that it be named after the Corbett Historic District which is near Monkton in Baltimore County, Maryland.

It has everything it takes to please the home gardener: beautiful star-shaped flowers in an interesting range of colors, a long blooming period, attractive foliage, excellent cold hardiness, ease of cultivation, reasonable availability in nurseries, etc. But it remains little known to the average gardener. Flowers of 'Virgin' are striking—comprised of a double-row of white rays set perpendicular to the stem and surrounding a domed green to green-yellow center cone.



Purple Emperor Coneflower

'Purple Emperor' produces large, fragrant, saturated magenta purple blossoms on sturdy, well-branched stems that are held in perfect proportion to the bushy clump of deep green foliage. As the flowers age, the tips of the petals turn a bit lighter pink but the center remains a bright magenta color.



Coral Craze Coneflower

'Coral Craze' has large, 5" vibrant coral pink flowers mature to lavender pink with wide petals. Dark, near black stems have a matching dark cone. The tallest of the collection.

Fairly compact, single flowering varieties, in bold colors with better basal branching compared to older genetics are hallmarks of the Eye-Catcher collection.



Tres Amigos Coneflower

'Tres Amigos' is a compact, upright, hybrid selection of coneflower that will reach up to 2' tall with a similar spread. The lightly fragrant blooms emerge coral-pink in color but mature to a bright rose-pink and fade to magenta. The flowering period starts in early summer and continues through mid-summer. The blooms are attractive to butterflies.



Crane Dance Wild Geranium

This bronze-leafed perennial may look like the species *Geranium pratense*, but is actually derived from *Geranium maculatum*, a woodland perennial and one of the few species in cultivation native to North America. This forms an upright habit topped with beautiful blue flowers. In the fall, the foliage turns bright red in zone 6. **'Crane Dance'** can grow in a range of conditions, from sun to shade.



Apricot Sparkles Daylily

'Apricot Sparkles' is an everblooming, winter dormant, diploid daylily that features apricot flowers (to 3-4") with ruffled edges and yellow-tinged center throats. Flowers appear to be diamond-dusted (they sparkle in the sun) as suggested by the cultivar name. (Replaces H. Ruffled Apricot)



Mauna Loa Daylily

We finally did it! **'Mauna Loa'** is the sister to one of our all-time favorite daylilies, South Seas. A TETRAPLOID cultivar which features 5" diameter, amber gold blend flowers with deep red wire edges and light green throats. Flowers appear on naked stems (scapes) which typically rise to 22" tall above a clump of arching, linear, blade-like leaves.

'Going Bananas' has never been a strong grower in our area as it does not go fully dormant in winter. This last year our main supplier lost much of their crop due to an unusually harsh winter, and plants are in short supply. '**Big Time Happy**' is our substitute, sharing a similar soft yellow flower color to 'Going Bananas' but boasts 4" wide flowers. Slightly ruffled petals open flat to display the yellow color, and blooms from early summer to frost. It is also fully dormant, a much hardier plant for our region.



Candy Apple Coral Bells

Coral Bells are a versatile perennial. This villosa hybrid, part of the Carnival series, known for their tidy mounding habit and excellent heat and humidity tolerance, has scalloped, deep red, semi-evergreen foliage that matures to red-green. Sprays of small flowers in summer.

Chartreuse yellow foliage has a silver overlay and matures to lime green. Foliage color is best in partial sunlight, and greener in full shade. Intense, rich rose-pink flowers contrast beautifully with the bright foliage. The foliage is more chartreuse yellow than the silver gray of 'Berry Timeless'.

Unlike other variegated varieties, **'Summer Carnival'** displays excellent vigor, has great flower coverage, and forms a beautifully shaped habit. 7", dark magenta pink flowers cover the upright, rounded habit. Each leaf has a narrow cream margin and the edges have a hint of blush. The perfect collector's item!



Cool as a Cucumber Hosta

This gorgeous large hosta forms an incredibly showy, cascading clump of green and white variegated foliage. Its foliage is notably upright in youth, but quickly develops into a gracefully arching mound. The long, tapered, pointed leaves have bright green margins which jet towards the clear white center. The leaves are also of greater substance than its parent, H. Cascades.



Guardian Angel Hosta

A large hosta; sport of 'Blue Angel'.

Large, thick, blue-green leaves display a white center in early spring.

By late spring, a unique green misting appears over the white center. Mature plants tend to keep their white center longer in the spring.

Dense clusters of light lavender flowers are produced in midsummer.

Makes a fantastic specimen plant, especially in spring when the variegation is most pronounced.



Risky Business Hosta

'**Risky Business**' is similar in habit to the cultivar 'Striptease' which it comes from. Green leaves have a creamy white streak in the middle of the leaf. The center line is quite narrow and occupies never more than 1/3 of leaf surface. A sharp contrast between white center and green border becomes stronger in the second part of the season. The leaves are slightly twisted. Foliage is topped with lavender flowers.

Sunfisher Siberian Iris

'**Sunfisher**' is one of the deepest yellow Siberian Iris on the market. Light yellow standards and deeper yellow falls form a beautiful display in early to midseason. It is one of the earliest of the Siberian Iris to bloom.



Coconut Shasta Daisy

Lovely, fluffy, white double daisies on a compact habit. We all loved this one instantly. It was an easy choice. The robust crown of this plant produces multiple flowers in the first year.

'Coconut' is tough as well! Coming through last years tough winter with flying colors. It joins Amelia as one of the hardiest Leucanthemum we've come across.

Firecracker Fringed Loosestrife

After multiple requests for this old favorite, we decided to bring her back! **Lysimachia ciliata** 'Firecracker' bears tall stems of pointed, dark purple leaves, which contrast beautifully with pale lemon flowers in July and August. It's perfect for growing in a mixed herbaceous border and will also thrive at the pond edge or bog garden. A well-behaved variety that deserves another chance.



Kitten Around Catmint

The popular 'Purrsian Blue' changed the way we thought of catmint by giving a solid performance in a cute little package. If that wasn't small enough for you, you'll love '**Kitten Around**'! Even more compact and petite than its predecessor, this plant forms a tight, round mound of aromatic foliage. Bright rosy purple calyxes hold periwinkle blue flowers. The perfect size for containers, edging the sunny border or filling in small spaces in the garden.



Golden Siberian Catmint

Nepeta sibirica 'Aurea' was “discovered” at our nursery by Liesl Radtke Thomas as a gold foliage founding from *Nepeta sibirica* seed. A W. & E. Beautiful gold foliage that can take the sun and contrasts beautifully with blue flowers. A standout in any garden or landscape. Now that you know the rest of the story, give it a try!



Felix Crousse Peony

This DOUBLE-FLOWERED type was introduced to America in 1881!

Back once more! **Parthenocissus tricuspidata 'Fenway Park'** is a gold foliage Boston Ivy. It needs shade on a north or east facing wall and ample moisture to do well, but the Fall foliage in shades of orange and russet make this an outstanding selection of Ivy.

Blue Jean Baby Russian Sage

During the 2020 season we had request upon request for **'Blue Jean Baby'**. A shorter, manageable Russian Sage that is still vigorous in the landscape and production. 'Blue Jean Baby' takes its place in our line up with 'Denim n' Lace'. Lavender blue flowers held in smoky purple calyxes bloom for a long period starting in midsummer, with the color from the calyxes extending appeal into Fall. This variety is one of the earliest Perovskia to bloom.



Daphnis Variegated Masterwort

Peucedanum ostruthium 'Daphnis' is an awful name for a beautiful plant. Looking like a large Aegopodium but much better behaved, it can fit into many shady areas of the landscape or garden. Need a specimen plant?...check! How about a replacement for the dreaded Snow-on-the-Mountain?(and it doesn't go dormant)...check! Need a fill-in or "facier plant" under a small tree or with other large shade perennials?... check! It even attracts butterflies to its huge, Queen Anne's Lace type flowers.



Cleopatra Garden Phlox

'Cleopatra' Tall or Garden Phlox is a real stunner in the perennial garden. Its unusual pleated petals give the blossoms that extra something special, just like Cleopatra herself. Fragrant, bright warm cherry pink flowers attract hummingbirds and butterflies. Those vivid blossoms will be the queen of the garden!



Pop Star™ Blue Balloon Flower

A fun perennial, '**Pop Star**' **Balloon Flower** features flower buds that swell into huge plump balloon-like orbs then pop open to reveal huge star-shaped violet blue, star-shaped blossoms. It has a very compact habit, growing only 6-8" tall and 10-12" wide. Long blooming, you can expect to see its beautiful blossoms throughout summer. (Replaces P. Sentimental Blue)

Dark Magic Stonecrop

It has to be dark magic to give so many great characteristics in one plant – amazing huge inflorescences, a short and very upright habit, glossy purple black leaves, dark pink flowers, and multiple crowns. In addition, 'Dark Magic' has been remarkably disease free and long-lived. (Replaces S. Chocolate Drop)



Frosted Fire Stonecrop

Sedum x 'Frosted Fire' replaces Sedum x 'Autumn Charm'. As lovely as 'Autumn Charm' was it had major reversion issues. 'Frosted Fire' is a selection of 'Autumn Fire' and similar to 'Autumn Charm', with bright rosy flowers and creamy yellow variegation.



Royal Ruby Hens-and-Chicks

Unavailable for a year or two while we built up stock, '**Royal Ruby**' makes itself known once more! It displays large, succulent rosettes of burgundy leaves with dark green tips. Color intensifies in cooler weather. Stalks of densely clustered, purple flowers appear in summer.
