



Abelia grandiflora 'Kaleidoscope'
Abelia (Code: 6770)
 The variegated leaves emerge yellow with light green centers. White tubular flowers bloom in fall. A stunning addition to any garden. Plant in full sun for best foliage color. (2-3' x 3-4') Zn6. PP16988 Propagation Prohibited.



Achillea 'Brass Buttons'
Yarrow (Code: 5338)
 Fresh green, ferny foliage forms a low mat. Small cream-colored buds open to golden-yellow flowers in the spring. Although delicate-looking, it is tough and durable. (3" x 12") Zn4.



Achillea 'King Edward'
Yarrow (Code: 2014)
 Cream-hued flowers grace this lovely, tufting, evergreen rock garden plant. A wonderful choice for the dry garden site. Requires good drainage. (4-6" x 10") Zn5.



Achillea 'Moonshine'
Yarrow (Code: 2010)
 Clusters of sulfur-yellow flowers top soft gray foliage most of the summer. This wonderful evergreen selection is a long time favorite with designers. (24" x 16") Zn4.



Achillea 'Walter Funcke'
Yarrow (Code: 7483)
 Brick-red flowers gradually fade to numerous lighter shades of orange-red. Silvery, drought tolerant foliage is the perfect foil for the long blooming flowers. (24" x 24") Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Appleblossom'
Yarrow (Code: 5113)
 Bright lilac-pink flowers fade to pastel pink on this long-blooming and easy to grow garden favorite. It makes an excellent cut flower. (2' x 2') Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Fireland'
Yarrow (Code: 6423)
 Drought tolerant perennial featuring orange-red flowers with prominent golden centers. The flowers fade to salmon pink, then tawny gold, creating a fiery effect. (20" x 24") Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Lilac Beauty'
Yarrow (Code: 4565)
 Lovely lilac pink flowers appear all summer. The flowers become lighter as they age, creating a multicolored effect that is very pleasing to the eye. It's perfect for the middle of the border. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Oertel's Rose'
Yarrow (Code: 6795)
 Bright orchid-pink blossoms slowly fade to nearly white. Hardy, drought tolerant and easy to grow. Showy all summer! (28" x 24") Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Paprika'
Yarrow (Code: 2021)
 Clusters of bright scarlet flowers with yellow centers fade beautifully to salmon-rose. Drought tolerant, easy to grow and good for bouquets. Long-blooming when deadheaded. (18-24" x 18-24") Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Salmon Beauty'
Yarrow (Code: 2024)
 Large, flat clusters of tiny blooms open in hues of deep salmon which brighten to soft pink. This drought tolerant and easy to grow selection also makes a great cut flower! (24-30" x 18-30") Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Summerwine'
Yarrow (Code: 4871)
 Stunning wine-red flowers glow over feathery green foliage in early summer. It's perfect for sunny locations. (24-28" x 24") Zn3.



Achillea millefolium 'Terra Cotta'
Yarrow (Code: 6146)
 Masses of dark salmon flowers mature to russet hues; the color of red clay! The fine feathery foliage is evergreen, easy to grow, and drought tolerant. (24-30" x 24-30") Zn3.



Achillea ptarmica 'Angel's Breath'
Yarrow (Code: 2025)
 Masses of 1/2" wide, pure white, double flowers appear in early summer and fade to ivory. The deep green, "ferny" foliage is extremely drought tolerant. (16" x 24") Zn4.





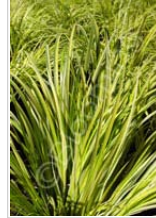
Achillea tomentosa 'Lemon' (aka 'Lemon Yellow Form')
Yarrow (Code: 2020)
 Lovely lemon yellow flowers are set off by ferny, evergreen foliage. Excellent in rock gardens or as a groundcover. (3-4" x 16") Zn4.



Achillea x kellereri
Yarrow (Code: 2027)
 Attractive white flowers top ferny leaves with a silvery-green, woolly appearance. Wonderful as a groundcover or for the rockery. (8" x 18") Zn3.



Acorus gramineus 'Oborozuki'
Striped Sweet Flag (Code: 4326)
 Grassy evergreen leaves with bright yellow stripes glimmer in the landscape. A graceful choice for moist soil or water's edge. (12" x 12") Zn6.



Acorus gramineus 'Ogon'
Sweet Flag (Code: 4254)
 The tufting, golden, evergreen foliage makes a striking border or accent plant. It even tolerates standing water. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (12" x 12") Zn6.



Agave 'Silver Surfer'
Century Plant (Code: 7277)
 Dramatic, rigid, silvery-blue succulent leaves grow into a 5' tall specimen plant! This architectural plant makes an exotic focal point in the garden or use in containers. (5' x 6-9") Zn8.



Agave gentryi 'Jaws'
Hardy Century Plant (Code: 7279)
 The name reflects the fantastic shape of the glossy evergreen leaves which are concave and heavily toothed. It forms a large dump that commands attention. (24" x 36-48") Zn7.



Agave montana 'Baccarat'
Mountain Agave (Code: 7282)
 This Agave features broad, blue-green evergreen leaves with beautiful silver markings on the back of the leaf, reminiscent of crystal etching. Perfect for desert rock gardens. (24-36" x 24-36") Zn7.



Agave ovatifolia 'Frosty Blue'
Agave (Code: 7627)
 One of the largest cold hardy Agaves, it can eventually grow up to 6 feet tall by 6 feet wide. The rounded rosette of short wide gray leaves are distinctively cupped with small teeth along their margins and a 1- inch long dark gray terminal spine. (6-8' x 4-6') Zn7.



Agave parryi
Parry's Agave (Code: 6301)
 Striking blue-green, sword-like succulent evergreen leaves have long spines. This classic desert garden plant is perfect as a dramatic focal point in the garden or as a container plant. (30-36" x 36-40") Zn7.



Agave parryi 'J.C. Raulston'
Parry's Agave (Code: 7285)
 This Agave forms symmetrical rosettes of blue-gray wedge-shaped evergreen leaves. Slow to form offsets, it is a good choice where space is small, or for use in containers. (24" x 24-36") Zn7.



Agave parryi ssp. huachucensis
Huachuca Agave (Code: 7284)
 This Agave forms very attractive rosettes of glaucous blue-gray, wedge-shaped evergreen leaves. Perfect for xeriscaping or for containers. (24" x 24") Zn7.



Agave parryi ssp. truncata
Silver Agave (Code: 7286)
 Blue-gray succulent leaves form a marvelous symmetrical rosette. Each rounded evergreen leaf terminates with a dark pointed spike. A classic and favorite among Agave collectors. (18" x 18") Zn7.



Agave schidigera 'Black Widow'
Agave (Code: 7288)
 Rigid, dark green succulent leaves have silver marking and edges with curly fibers. The compact symmetrical growth habit makes it useful in the rock garden or in containers. (12" x 18") Zn8.



Ajuga 'Chocolate Chip'
Bugleweed (Code: 4468)
 Bright blue flower spikes top miniature chocolate colored foliage in spring. This marvelously-dense, vigorous, spreading groundcover is excellent in containers or rock gardens. (3" x 18") Zn4.





Ajuga reptans 'Black Scallop'
Bugleweed (Code: 3940)
 Very attractive jet-black scalloped leaves are covered with deep violet-blue flower spikes in spring. The foliage color intensifies in cold and full sun. (3-6" x 30-36") Zn3.
 PP15815 Propagation Prohibited.



Ajuga reptans 'Blueberry Muffin'
Carpet Bugle (Code: 7393)
 Blueberry-blue blooms on 8" spikes shine above small-leaved foliage in spring. Faster and stronger growing than A. 'Chocolate Chip', this vigorous groundcover is weather resistant as well. (5-6" x 24-30") Zn4. PPAF,PVR
 Propagation Prohibited



Ajuga reptans 'Burgundy Glow'
Bugleweed (Code: 2032)
 In spring, blue flower spikes rise above a colorful low mat of burgundy-rose, white and green-variegated foliage. An eye-catching selection! (6" x 24") Zn6.



Ajuga reptans 'Catlin's Giant'
Bugleweed (Code: 5166)
 Unusual large-growing Ajuga with dramatic thick foliage and tall blue flower spikes. The leaves grow even larger with rich soil. It's stunning planted en masse, as border edging, or over bulbs. (9" x 36") Zn3.



Anacyclus depressus 'Silver Kisses'
Mt. Atlas Daisy (Code: 2076)
 Gray, filigreed leaves form a prostrate mat. Pretty white daisies with maroon reverse sides appear in abundance May to August. An excellent groundcover or rockery specimen. (4" x 8-10") Zn6.



Antennaria dioica 'Rubra'
Pussy Toes (Code: 6663)
 Deep red flowerheads appear on 4-8" stems above tufts of tiny, tight gray leaves. Forms a low, creeping mat that is perfect between paving stones or for the sunny rock garden. This is a tough plant that will take hot spots and poor, dry soil. (4-6" x 12") Zn4.



Arabis caucasica 'Pixie Cream'
Rock Cress (Code: 4067)
 Creamy-yellow flowers with bright yellow eyes cover velvety gray-green foliage in spring. This rock garden plant prefers well-drained soil, and moderate temperatures. (3-4" x 12") Zn3.



Arabis caucasica 'Snowcap'
Rock Cress (Code: 2140)
 This low-growing perennial is great for rock gardens or cascading over walls. Beautiful pure white flowers sparkle in spring. (4" x 12") Zn3.



Arabis caucasica 'Variegata'
Rock Cress (Code: 5356)
 Striking emerald and cream, felted evergreen leaves are topped with pure white flowers in spring. The late season foliage is very attractive. A collector's plant. (8" x 24") Zn3.



Arabis ferdinandi-coburgi 'Old Gold'
Rock Cress (Code: 5720)
 This vigorous low spreader has great evergreen leaves with wide chartreuse margins. White flowers appear in May. (4" x 18") Zn4.



Arabis x arendsii 'La Fraicheur'
Rock Cress (Code: 4069)
 Rose-pink flowers cover gray-green foliage in April. This rock garden plant prefers well-drained soil and moderate temperatures. (3-4" x 12") Zn3.



Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Massachusetts'
Kinnikinnick, Bearberry (Code: 5674)
 This popular native evergreen groundcover is very cold and drought tolerant. Small pink flowers bloom in early spring and are followed by bright red berries in fall. (4" x 36-72") Zn3.



Arctostaphylos uva-ursi 'Vancouver Jade'
Kinnikinnick (Code: 6383)
 Small pink flowers in spring turn into scarlet-red fruit in summer and fall. This drought tolerant, glossy-leaved, evergreen groundcover is deservedly popular. (4" x 36-72") Zn3.



Arenaria montana
Sandwort (Code: 2147)
 Charming, low growing perennial with profuse, cup-shaped, white flowers that bloom atop small, deep green leaves. Perfect for tucking into spaces in a rock wall, or into cracks between pavers. (4" x 18") Zn4.





Armeria 'Victor Reiter'
Sea Thrift (Code: 5090)
 This small, tufting Armeria resembles a dwarf Dianthus. A profusion of tiny pink ball-shaped flowers bloom for a long time over grassy evergreen leaves. (3-5" x 12") Zn4.



Armeria maritima 'Dusseldorf'
Sea Thrift (Code: 2151)
 Deep rose-pink, global flowers grace this compact evergreen perennial from spring into summer and again in fall. Perfect for the alpine or rock garden. (6-8" x 12") Zn4.



Armeria maritima 'Rubrifolia'
Sea Thrift (Code: 2938)
 Grassy burgundy foliage forms a tight evergreen dump, topped by numerous rose-pink clusters of flowers from spring into summer. (6" x 9") Zn4.



Artemisia 'Powis Castle'
Wormwood (Code: 2159)
 Soft, sturdy, gray leaves form a mound of finely-divided foliage. A wonderful textural accent for the garden. It can also be used as small evergreen hedge. (24-36" x 24-36") Zn6.



Artemisia labrotanum limoneum
Lemon Southernwood (Code: 8215)
 Large-growing, shrubby perennial with ferny, gray-green, citrus-scented leaves. Tiny yellowish flowers appear in fall. The leaves can be dried and used to make a fragrant sachet said to repel moths. (36" x 36") Zn4.



Artemisia pycnocephala 'David's Choice'
Wormwood (Code: 2167)
 Delicate silver foliage forms attractive soft mounds. This beautiful dwarf evergreen selection makes an excellent addition to the rock garden. (12" x 24-36") Zn7.



Asarum caudatum
Wild Ginger (Code: 5167)
 Northwest native perennial with evergreen heart-shaped leaves that slowly grow to form a groundcover. It grows best in moist, but well drained soils in open woodlands. (4-5" x 18-24") Zn4.



Asarum europaeum
European Wild Ginger (Code: 2174)
 This evergreen groundcover forms a lush carpet of glossy green leaves. Unusual purplish-green flowers appear hidden beneath the foliage in late spring. It grows best in rich, moist soil in part shade. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (3" x 12") Zn4.



Azara microphylla
Boxleaf Azara, Chinchin (Code: 6477)
 This small tree has dark, glossy evergreen foliage similar to boxwood. Tiny yellow flowers scented of white chocolate appear in late winter, followed by tiny blood-red fruit. It prefers well-drained soil. (15' x 6') Zn7.



Azorella trifurcata 'Nana' (Bolax glebaria 'Nana')
Cushion Plant (Code: 5456)
 Small, tough, rigid leaves grow tightly together, forming a textured mound. An unusual and wonderful, evergreen spreader, great for spilling around rocks or edging paths. (12" x 6") Zn3.



Baumea rubiginosa
Golden Sword (Code: 6995)
 Fabulous foliage! Upright, leathery leaves are striped green and gold, making it an excellent vertical accent. Needs full to part sun and moisture. Excellent for containers and pond edges. (18" x 10") Zn7.



Bergenia 'Abendglocken'
Elephant Ears (Code: 5097)
 This dump form has large glossy, leathery evergreen foliage which turns a beautiful maroon color in fall and winter. Flower spikes are a rich magenta. (14" x 14") Zn3.



Bergenia 'Abendglut'
Elephant Ears (Code: 5629)
 This improved form has lovely deep-magenta, semi-double bells lining upright red stems, March to May. The evergreen foliage adds substance to the border and turns maroon in winter. An excellent selection! (18" x 12") Zn3.



Bergenia 'Bressingham Ruby'
Elephant Ears (Code: 3648)
 Best known for its ruby-red winter foliage, this Bergenia has deep rose-pink flowers in spring. It's useful as a groundcover or as an accent in containers. (14" x 12") Zn4. PP7344, COPF Propagation Prohibited.





Bergenia 'Glockenturm'
Elephant Ears (Code: 5098)
 Sturdy evergreen leaves turn purple-maroon in winter. Deep magenta flowers appear in spring, then sporadically through summer & fall. A wonderful textural accent for the late season garden. (18" x 18") Zn3.



Bergenia 'Morgenrote'
Elephant Ear (Code: 5099)
 Short racemes of deep carmine flowers top crinkled deep green leaves. This pretty rebloomer has very attractive burgundy fall and winter foliage. (18" x 12") Zn3.



Bergenia 'Pink Dragonfly'
Elephant Ear (Code: 4073)
 This Bergenia forms a low dump of tidy narrow green leaves, that develop rich plum-red tones in the winter. Taller stems of bell-shaped pink flowers rise above the shiny foliage in mid spring. (12-15" x 15") Zn3.



Bergenia 'Ruby Elf'
Dwarf Elephant Ears (Code: 5901)
 A lovely dwarf, compact plant with succulent green summer leaves that turn burgundy-red in winter. Pretty clusters of ruby-red bells display on 10" stems in spring. A great addition to the semi-shade border and wonderful for mixed containers. (12" x 12") Zn3.



Bergenia 'Silberlicht'
Elephant Ear (Code: 5100)
 Delicate white flowers age to pink and appear above large medium-green foliage. This vigorous grower exhibits nice red-tinted fall and winter color and is great for mass planting. (18" x 24") Zn3.



Bergenia agavifolia
Elephant Ears (Code: 4820)
 This unusual bergenia has round, olive green leaves, edged in burgundy. White blooms with pink calyxes appear in early spring. (12" x 12-16") Zn3.



Bergenia cordifolia 'Winterglut'
Elephant Ears (Code: 2390)
 Showy magenta-red flowers bloom in spring and periodically in fall. Large, rounded evergreen foliage turns glowing burgundy in fall and winter and is excellent for mass planting. (12-15" x 18") Zn3.



Bergenia hybrida 'Baby Doll'
Elephant Ears (Code: 6006)
 Delicate pink flowers age to a deeper pink in spring. The foliage is smaller than most varieties of bergenia, reaching a mere 10" tall. An excellent evergreen accent. (12-24" x 18-24") Zn3.



Bergenia purpurascens
Elephant Ears (Code: 2267)
 Reddish-purple flowers in spring enhance deep-green leaves that have a reddish hue to their undersides. This easy to grow evergreen turns burgundy in winter and early spring. (15" x 24") Zn3.



Blechnum spicant
Deer Fern (Code: 7488)
 This NW native, tufted fern has compact, symmetrical, lustrous evergreen fronds. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest, it is an essential ingredient for the natural woodland garden, as either an accent plant or groundcover. (16" x 24") Zn5.



Calceolaria biflora 'Goldcap'
Pocketbook Flower (Code: 7024)
 This petite charmer is adorned with sweet, pouch-like blooms of golden-yellow, dotted with red. The evergreen foliage rosette adds interest. Perfect for the shady rock garden. (12" x 8") Zn6.



Calluna vulgaris 'Lady in White'
Heather (Code: 7796)
 This small evergreen shrub has bushy, upright branches covered with white flowers from August until January. Flowering branches make a wonderful addition to garlands and wreaths. Prefers cool summers and moist, but well-drained acidic soil. (8-18" x 8-14") Zn5. PP20530



Calocedrus decurrens
Incense Cedar (Code: 7272)
 This 'NW native conifer has a narrow conical shape with reddish brown bark. The scale-like, fragrant, evergreen leaves form flat sprays and carry cinnamon colored seed cones. It is excellent when used for tall hedges. (50' x 10') Zn5.



Calocephalus (Leucophyta) brownii
Cushion Bush (Code: 5429)
 This heavily-branched, chalk white, woolly shrub is dramatic and unusual. Topped by yellow button flowers in summer, it is a wonderful twiggy accent for containers and an excellent choice for the rockery. (18-24" x 24") Zn8.





Campanula persicifolia 'Alba'
Peach-Leaved Bellflower (Code: 2304)
 Large sparkling-white bells on 24" tall stems are a perfect selection for the cutting garden or mixed perennial border. (2-3" x 18") Zn4.



Campanula persicifolia 'Hidcote Amethyst'
Peach Leaved Bellflower (Code: 2282)
 Lovely, large rosy-lavender bells line up 2' stalks. Adds a nice touch of mid-season color to the cottage garden. A hard to find old-fashioned variety. (24" x 18") Zn3.



Campanula persicifolia 'La Belle'
Peach-Leaved Bellflower (Code: 4456)
 Double China-blue bellflowers appear like little roses on short stems in early summer and grows to only 2' tall. The basal foliage is nearly evergreen. (24" x 18") Zn4.



Campanula persicifolia 'Telham Beauty'
Peach Leaved Bellflower (Code: 2303)
 Large, open blue flowers are carried on 3' stems. Easy to grow and maintain, makes a wonderful cut flower. A sweet addition to the mixed perennial border. (2-3" x 18") Zn4.



Campanula portenschlagiana
Bellflower (Code: 5476)
 This vigorous evergreen creeper bears large clusters of open, violet-blue, bell-shaped flowers that bloom for months. Drought tolerant, it's a "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest. It will re-seed and naturalize to form a small colony. (4" x 24") Zn4.



Campanula poscharskyana
Adriatic Bellflower (Code: 2306)
 A lovely, vigorous perennial with blue starry flowers that bloom for months. Drought tolerant and very adaptable, it's a "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest. (6-9" x 14") Zn4.



Campanula poscharskyana 'Blue Gown'
Adriatic Bellflower (Code: 2254)
 Star-like true-blue flowers are larger than the species and cover this low-growing variety for many months. Excellent in rock gardens or spilling over walls and container edges. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (12" x 18") Zn3.



Carex buchananii
Leather Leaf Sedge (Code: 2328)
 Copper-bronze leaves with curly tops make a dramatic accent in the mixed border or container. The graceful, upright form looks best contrasted with silver foliage or with brightly colored flowers. (24" x 18") Zn7.



Carex buchananii 'Viridis'
Leather Leaf Sedge (Code: 5655)
 This graceful, finely-textured, evergreen grass forms an upright clump of curly-topped light green leaves. It makes a striking accent for the perennial border or container. (18-24" x 18") Zn7.



Carex comans 'Frosted Curls'
New Zealand Hairy Sedge (Code: 2511)
 Very graceful, finely-textured, pale silver-green leaves form a low arching mound of foliage. It makes a beautiful, soft-textured evergreen groundcover when planted in groups. (12" x 16") Zn7.



Carex comans 'Milk Chocolate'
New Zealand Hairy Sedge (Code: 4236)
 Delicious milk chocolate-colored, evergreen grass with long thin blades that curve gracefully outward. Similar to C. 'Frosted Curls' but with a rich brownish-red hue. (12" x 12-24") Zn7.



Carex dolichostachya 'Kaga nishiki'
Gold Fountain Sedge (Code: 4805)
 Fine green leaves have a gold stripe along each edge. Low and fountain-like, this sedge works well in drifts, as a formal border or specimen. Tolerant of many conditions and exposures. (12" x 24") Zn5.



Carex flacca
Blue Sedge (Code: 3734)
 Evergreen chalky-blue blades spread to form a groundcover that will tolerate shade. Blue flowers on blue stems appear in early summer. (15" x 15") Zn4.



Carex flacca 'Blue Zinger'
Carex (Code: 4239)
 Tufted bluish-gray, grassy foliage slowly spreads to form an evergreen groundcover. Very versatile and easy to grow. (10-18" x 12-16") Zn5.





Carex flagellifera
Weeping Brown Sedge (Code: 2281)
 This graceful and finely-textured grass has arching mounds of orange-bronze foliage. It makes a nice contrast with silver foliage and brightly colored flowers. (18" x 24") Zn7.



Carex flagellifera 'Kiwi'
Sedge (Code: 4941)
 A soft fountain-like evergreen with finely-textured pale green blades and yellow highlights. Perfect for containers and borders. Golden highlights appear in fall. (18" x 18") Zn7.



Carex morrowii 'Aureovariegata'
Variegated Sedge (Code: 2329)
 This easy-to-grow evergreen grass forms a mounding clump of butter-yellow-striped leaves with green edges. A truly beautiful sedge, useful as an accent, in groups as a groundcover, or as a container subject. (12" x 15") Zn5.



Carex morrowii 'Ice Dance'
Variegated Sedge (Code: 6653)
 Dark green leaves with white edges form arching mounds of evergreen foliage. It will spread to form a groundcover that's easy to control. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (12" x 18") Zn5.



Carex morrowii 'Silver Sceptre'
Sedge (Code: 4752)
 Green leaves with silver-white edges form dense, creeping tufts. Pale and wispy flowers appear in late spring. An excellent evergreen groundcover among Hostas, ferns or bamboo. (18" x 42") Zn6.



Carex nigra 'Variegata'
Variegated Sedge (Code: 6297)
 Light green blades to 12" are softly edged in yellow. This vigorous groundcover is good for partial shade. It will also tolerate drier soils. (12" x 18") Zn5.



Carex oshimensis 'Evergold'
Sedge (Code: 3890)
 This popular clump-forming sedge has light yellow blades with green edges. The evergreen foliage is a standout in the garden any time of year. (10-12" x 12") Zn5.



Carex subfusca
Rusty Sedge (Code: 7419)
 This native western US sedge is found everywhere from the sea to the desert. Low growing with narrow, upright, dark green leaves, it spreads to form a low maintenance lawn or groundcover. Easy to grow in almost any situation. (4-10" x 18-36") Zn5.



Carex testacea
Copper Hair Sedge (Code: 5540)
 Unusual, finely-textured bronzy blades turn nearly orange in sun and almost olive-green in shade. It forms a rounded mound of arching foliage that is excellent for rock gardens, massing, or container plantings. (16" x 12") Zn6.



Carex tumulicola
Berkeley Sedge (Code: 6823)
 Very narrow bright green blades form evergreen clumps. Use as a groundcover under trees or in moist areas. It reseeds readily. Native to the Pacific Northwest. (12" x 18") Zn7.



Ceanothus 'Centennial'
California Lilac (Code: 6670)
 This low-growing, spreading, evergreen shrub has dark blue flowers in spring. A native cultivar of the Pacific coast, it is tolerant of summer heat and drought. (8-12" x 72") Zn7.



Ceanothus 'Dark Star'
California Lilac (Code: 6748)
 A beautiful evergreen shrub with very nice, small and slightly cupped deep green leaves. Cobalt-blue flowers completely cover the foliage in late spring. (6' x 8-12') Zn7.



Ceanothus 'Italian Skies'
California Lilac (Code: 3743)
 This stunning evergreen shrub has a dense mounding habit with small dark green leaves. Luminous deep blue flowers cover the shrub in spring. Award of Merit, RHS 1984. (6-8' x 6-10') Zn7.



Ceanothus 'Joyce Coulter'
California Lilac (Code: 6745)
 Sky-blue fragrant flowers, held in 3-5" spike-like clusters, cover this evergreen shrub in spring. With a low-growing, spreading habit, it makes a good groundcover or low hedge. (30-36' x 4-8') Zn7.





Ceanothus 'Julia Phelps'
California Lilac (Code: 2116)

This large, mounding, evergreen shrub puts on a spectacular display of indigo-blue flowers in spring. This drought tolerant and deer resistant shrub has remained popular for over 50 years. (5-8' x 6-9') Zn7.



Ceanothus 'Victoria'
California Lilac (Code: 6712)

Masses of vivid dark blue flowers appear mid-spring. It grows into a lovely medium sized shrub with glossy evergreen leaves. Tough and trouble-free, it is a "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (4-6' x 6') Zn7.



Ceanothus gloriosus (Pt Reyes)
Point Reyes Ceanothus (Code: 7050)

Lavender-blue flower clusters in spring top shiny evergreen foliage on a nice low-spreading shrub. It makes an excellent groundcover when planted en masse. (2' x 4') Zn7.



Ceanothus griseus var. horizontalis 'Diamond Heights'
California Lilac (Code: 6833)

Gorgeous lime-green foliage has dark pine-green detail down the spine of each leaf. Lovely bright blue flowers appear in spring. Great for mild coastal gardens, it prefers partial shade when grown in hot locations. (8-12" x 24-36") Zn8.



Ceanothus impressus 'Vandenberg'
California Lilac (Code: 6907)

Cistus 'Blanche'
Rockrose (Code: 4706)

Fragrant, large white blossoms with large yellow centers bloom in late spring and early summer. Medium-sized evergreen shrub with bright green, wavy-edged leaves. Drought tolerant. (4-5' x 4-5') Zn7.



Cistus 'Elma'
Rockrose (Code: 5618)

Very large, white single flowers top lustrous dark green foliage in early summer. A wonderful, drought-tolerant evergreen selection with an upright habit. (4-5' x 4-5') Zn7.





Cistus 'Silver Pink'

Rockrose (Code: 4192)

Lovely pale salmon-pink flowers cover this small, rather open bush in late spring and early summer. The evergreen leaves have grayish undersides. It tolerates poor soil, dry slopes and maritime conditions. (2' x 2') Zn8.



Cistus incanus 'Creticus'

Rock Rose (Code: 7063)

This evergreen shrub has wavy silver foliage highlighted by rose-pink flowers in early summer. Great for the rockery, it is an excellent drought-tolerant selection. (36" x 30") Zn8.



Cistus salviifolius 'Prostratus'

Prostrate Rockrose (Code: 7065)

Cistus x corbariensis

White Rockrose (Code: 5680)

Iberis sempervirens 'Kingwood Compact'

Iberis sempervirens 'Purity'
Candytuft (Code: 2906)
 Large white flower clusters cover glossy deep green foliage for months in spring. A carefree evergreen accent, perfect for massing or for the rockery. (8-10" x 12") Zn3.



Iberis sempervirens 'Snowflake'
Candytuft (Code: 2907)

Lavandula angustifolia 'Betty Blue'
English Lavender (Code: 4683)
 This English Lavender cultivar is excellent for fresh cut flowers or for drying. The deep blue-violet flowers have a dark purple calyx with a violet corolla. The flowers are somewhat taller than the species. (2-3' x 2') Zn5.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Bowles'
English Lavender (Code: 8072)
 Spikes of lavender flowers and aromatic gray-green foliage makes this herb a standout in the garden. Maintains a tidy rounded habit. (18" x 16") Zn5.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Buena Vista'
English Lavender (Code: 3102)
 Showy deep lavender flowers shine on this sweetly-fragrant strain. It may bloom twice each season if cut back. Excellent for dry flowers too! (2' x 2') Zn5.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote Pink'
English Lavender (Code: 4312)
 A wonderful compact grower, just like the popular L. 'Hidcote', but with pink flower spikes. Good for mid-border or near walkways, it performs best in full sun. (18" x 18") Zn5.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Hidcote'
English Lavender (Code: 8075)

English Lavender (Code: 8073)
 This compact growing herb features light purple flowers and an earlier bloom time than most Lavender. The fragrant flowers dry well. (14" x 12-18") Zn5.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Premier'
English Lavender (Code: 3100)
 Fragrant gray-green, evergreen foliage is topped by aromatic purple flower spikes. Dries well, and even reblooms in fall. (2' x 2') Zn5.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Purple Bouquet'
English Lavender (Code: 3234)
 This Lavender has long stems and very dark purple blooms in summer. An attractive addition to any garden, it also rewards with bouquets of sweetly fragrant blossoms. (18-24" x 24-30") Zn5.



Lavandula angustifolia 'Sachet'
English Lavender (Code: 3098)
 Sweetly-scented lavender flower spikes top this gray-green, compact sub-shrub. It prefers a sunny spot with well-drained soil. (12-15" x 18-24") Zn5.

Lavandula angustifolia 'Violet Intrigue'
English Lavender (Code: 4887)

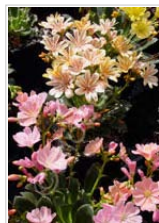

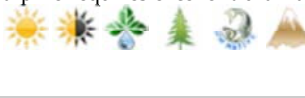

Box Honeysuckle (Code: 7494)

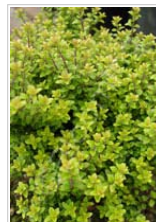

Sedum album 'Athoum'
Stonecrop (Code: 7645)
 Plump, round, evergreen leaves are much larger than the species and remain apple-green in winter. The leaves will often turn slightly red in the heat of summer when the white flowers appear. It's wonderful as a groundcover for sunny sites. (2-4" x 18-24") Zn4.



Sedum album 'Black Pearl'
White Flowering Stonecrop (Code: 6271)
 The creeping bronze-purple succulent evergreen foliage holds its color well into summer. White panicles appear in summer. It can be used in containers, rock gardens, trailing over rock walls or as a groundcover. (2-3" x 12-24") Zn4.



Sedum album 'Chloroticum'
Stonecrop (Code: 4581)
 Miniature, pale green, evergreen leaves brighten alpine planters or rock gardens. White starry flowers bloom in summer. (1-3" x 12") Zn3.

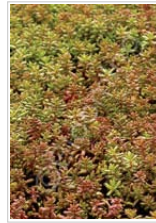

Turkish Stonecrop (Code: 6592)

Sedum confusum
Stonecrop (Code: 6226)
 This mounding, evergreen Sedum is bushy and compact in growth. Large, bright yellow terminal panicles 3-4" across top shiny oval, green leaves. (10-12" x 12-15") Zn8.

Stonecrop (Code: 6933)
 This low-growing Sedum has pebble-like, succulent bluish-green foliage that has a purple-mauve tint. A good groundcover for hot, dry conditions. Tiny white flowers appear in early summer. (4" x 18") Zn6.



Sedum divergens
Cascade Stonecrop (Code: 4391)

Sedum pachyclados
Stonecrop (Code: 3918)
 Low-growing succulent with gray-blue, evergreen foliage and silvery-pink flowers in summer. A great plant for the rock garden or rock wall. 2009 "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (1-3" x 6") Zn3.



Sedum reflexum 'Blue Spruce'
Stonecrop (Code: 6932)
 The blue-green spruce-like, succulent foliage is topped by bright yellow flowers in early summer. A great evergreen groundcover for hot, dry conditions, but it also thrives in part shade. (6-8" x 24") Zn3.



Sedum reflexum 'Green Spruce'
Stonecrop (Code: 3914)
 The low-growing evergreen, spruce-like, succulent foliage is perfect for a sunny rock garden. Yellow flowers appear in July. (1-3" x 18") Zn3.



Sedum rupestre 'Angelina'
Stonecrop (Code: 3306)

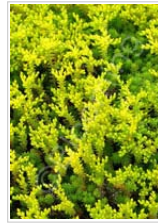

Sedum spathulifolium 'Purpureum'

Stonecrop (Code: 3485)

Sedum stefco

Stonecrop (Code: 4447)

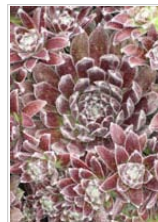

Hens & Chicks (Code: 3529)

Succulent evergreen rosettes are heavily-tufted, fringed, and frosty-red in color. It makes an excellent selection for rockeries and containers. (2-3" x 6") Zn3.



Sempervivum 'Jubilee'

Hens & Chicks, Houseleek (Code: 7470)

This variety changes color during the year. Leaves start out light green then age to dark red late in the year. It is also lightly covered in hairs. (2-3" x 4-6") Zn3.



Sempervivum 'Jungle Shadows'

Hens & Chicks (Code: 3530)

Rosettes of dark purplish-gray, evergreen foliage with bright purple edges. Dramatic container or rockery accent! (2-4" x 12") Zn3.



Sempervivum 'Lavender & Old Lace'

Hens & Chicks (Code: 3531)

Smokey gray-green rosettes are highlighted with rosy-lavender. Fine silver hairs appear along the evergreen leaf margins. A great addition to any rockery. (2-3" x 6") Zn3.



Sempervivum 'Pekinese'

Hens & Chicks (Code: 5267)

Small mounds of light to creamy-green, evergreen rosettes exhibit a flush of red in the spring. Pale rose flowers bloom in summer on short stalks. (2-3" x 6") Zn3.

 Succulent green rosettes, larger than the species, have a light spidery webbing of white threads. The foliage turns crimson in winter. It offsets freely to form a dense mat. (2-4" x 8-12") Zn3.



Sempervivum arachnoideum 'Cebenense'
Hens and Chicks, Houseleek (Code: 7469)
 Rosettes of tight, succulent, red-green triangular leaves, are connected with fine white hairs, giving the appearance of being covered in cobwebs. Pink to red flowers appear in summer. (2-3" x 4-6") Zn3.



Sempervivum arachnoideum 'Stansfieldii'
Cobweb Houseleek (Code: 3691)
 White, frosty "webs" cover flat-topped rosettes that take on a red tinge in spring. Good choice for crevices or rockery. (2-3" x 12") Zn5.



Sempervivum arachnoideum ssp. tomentosum
Hens & Chicks (Code: 3725)
 Heavy cobwebs cover tiny green, rose-edged rosettes. A mysterious and unique variety for tucking into rockery crevices. (3" x 12") Zn3.



Sempervivum calcareum 'Mrs. Giuseppi'
Hens & Chicks (Code: 3926)
 Large, green-gray, evergreen rosettes have deep red tips and pink flowers in summer. It has a more compact growth habit than the species. (1-3" x 6") Zn3.



Sempervivum montanum var. braunii
Hens & Chicks (Code: 3925)
 Small green, evergreen rosettes can display a pinkish hue early in the season. Sharply-pointed tips are occasionally flushed with red. Yellow flowers appear midsummer. (2-3" x 6") Zn3.



Senecio greyi
Daisy Bush (Code: 7250)
 This handsome shrub has large, finely-felted, oval-shaped, silver colored leaves. Golden-yellow, daisy-like flowers appear sparsely in summer. Drought tolerant and a great plant for contrast. (4' x 5') Zn8.



Sesleria autumnalis
Autumn Moor Grass (Code: 3542)
 Finely-textured light evergreen blades form a nice rounded clump that is drought tolerant. Tight creamy-white flower spikes appear late summer and persist into winter. It can be massed for a dramatic effect. (16" x 12") Zn5.



Sesleria caerulea
Blue Moor Grass (Code: 5544)
 Attractive compact, evergreen grass displays both sea-blue & green leaf blades simultaneously. The low growing, dumping form makes this grass excellent for edging. (8" x 12") Zn4.



Sisyrinchium californicum 'Yellow Stone'
Golden Blue-eyed Grass (Code: 5585)
 This easy-care West Coast native has grass-like leaves and yellow star-like flowers in summer. Thrives in poor soil and stays neat and compact. (5-6" x 6") Zn7.



Sisyrinchium striatum
Yellow-Eyed Grass (Code: 3560)
 The Iris-like leaves are arranged like a fan. 1" cream-colored flowers with yellow centers are arranged up and around sturdy stems. Very showy when in bloom. (30" x 18") Zn7.



Stachys b. 'Countess Helen von Stein Zeppelin'
Lamb's Ear (Code: 5717)

Stachys byzantina 'Primrose Heron'
Lamb's Ear (Code: 5716)

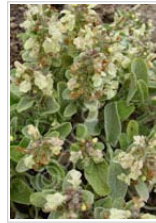

Stachys chrysantha
Lamb's Ear (Code: 4896)

Stachys densiflora 'Rosea'
Betony (Code: 3574)
 Dense rosy spikes in summer. (1-2' x 1') Zn4.



Teucrium chamaedrys
Germander (Code: 6522)
 Neat little evergreen sub-shrub that can take trimming into mini-hedges or knot gardens. Glossy, deep green leaves and pretty lilac-pink flowers complete the picture. (15" x 15") Zn5.



Teucrium chamaedrys 'Nanum'
Germander (Code: 8237)
 This lovely dwarf edging plant is an excellent addition to the herb garden. The glossy, evergreen, scallop-edged foliage is aromatic and contrasts beautifully with rosy-purple flowers. (6" x 12") Zn5.



Teucrium chamaedrys 'Summer Sunshine'
Germander (Code: 3764)
 Beautiful bright golden, evergreen foliage has purple-pink flowers. A real eye-catcher that's sure to get lots of attention. Drought tolerant once established. (6-8" x 12-16") Zn5.



Teucrium fruticans 'Azereum'
Silver Germander (Code: 6684)
 Vivid blue flowers contrast nicely against silvery-white leaves on this small evergreen shrub. It prefers a sunny, sheltered position in well-drained soil. (3-4' x 3') Zn7.



Thuja plicata
Western Red Cedar (Code: 7238)
 Tall, NW native conifer with tiny scale-like leaves arranged in flattened sprays. Small seed cones face upward on the branches. The wood is rot resistant. It prefers moist, well-drained soil. (50' x 20') Zn5.



Thymus 'Gold Transparent'
Creeping Thyme (Code: 3603)
 Shimmering gold and green foliage grows low and fast for a sun-loving, hardy, evergreen groundcover. Lilac blooms appear late summer. (3" x 12") Zn5.



Thymus doerfleri 'Bressingham'
Creeping Thyme (Code: 5943)
 A carpet of fuzzy gray-green, evergreen leaves and soft pink flowers makes it a dainty accent for the rocky, between pavers, or at borders edge. Best in full sun with good drainage. (4" x 18") Zn4.



Thymus herba-barona
Caraway Thyme (Code: 8245)
 Dark green leaves have a delightful caraway scent and flavor. Good in culinary dishes; especially stir fry and meat. It's ideal for the rock garden. (4" x 16") Zn6.



Thymus hyemalis
Winter Thyme (Code: 8261)
 This tough, compact, evergreen Thyme is prized for it's oil. (1' x 1') Zn3.



Thymus longicaulis
Creeping Thyme (Code: 7716)
 This spreading evergreen carpet of foliage has pink flowers in summer. Small pine scented leaves can be used to flavor meats. (3-5" x 18-24") Zn5.



Thymus praecox 'Albus'
Creeping Thyme (Code: 3614)
 Starry white flowers top tiny bright green leaves. It forms a fragrant, tightly-matted groundcover underfoot; perfect along pathways or between pavers. (1" x 12") Zn4.





Thymus praecox 'Coccineus'
Creeping Thyme (Code: 3612)
 Dainty rose-red flowers completely cover this creeping thyme in summer. The evergreen foliage turns somewhat red in winter. (2-3" x 18") Zn4.



Thymus praecox 'Hartington Silver'
Silver Creeping Thyme (Code: 4709)
 Creeping English thyme with beautiful, aromatic, tiny green leaves edged in gold. It makes an excellent mat-forming, evergreen groundcover or use between pavers. (2-3" x 12") Zn4.



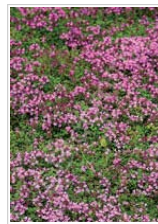
Thymus praecox 'Minus'
Miniature Creeping Thyme (Code: 3615)
 Tiny, overlapping, gray-green, evergreen leaves form a low mat. Small pink flowers appear midsummer. Nice for planting between pavers. (1" x 10") Zn4.



Thymus praecox 'Nutmeg'
Creeping Thyme (Code: 8256)
 A profusion of deep purple-carmine blooms cover this tight, deep green, evergreen groundcover in summer. It is drought tolerant and sun loving. (1" x 12") Zn4.

Creeping Thyme (Code: 3609)

Creeping Thyme (Code: 4449)

Thymus pseudolanuginosus
Woolly Thyme (Code: 3606)
 Soft, completely prostrate, silvery-green, evergreen foliage has pink flowers in summer. It handles foot traffic well and is excellent for use between pavers. (1" x 12") Zn4.



Thymus pulegioides 'Foxy'
Variegated Thyme (Code: 4448)
 Mounds of soft, shiny, cream & green-variegated evergreen foliage contrasts nicely with dark pink blooms in summer. Perfect in rockeries, along paths or the herb garden. (8" x 12") Zn7.



Thymus thracicus 'Lavender'
Lavender-Scented Thyme (Code: 5461)
 Wonderful needle-leaved culinary thyme has a rich fragrance similar to lavender. It can also be used as a drought tolerant, evergreen groundcover. (10" x 18") Zn5.



Thymus vulgaris 'Dot Wells'
French Thyme (Code: 3759)
 An upright grower ideal for the culinary garden. Pale pink flowers bloom from summer to fall over the very fragrant foliage. (6-12" x 12") Zn4.



Thymus vulgaris 'English Wedgewood'
French Thyme (Code: 5412)

Orange Thyme (Code: 5531)

Thymus vulgaris 'Silver Posie'
Variegated Thyme (Code: 6860)

Thymus x 'Pink Ripple'
Pink Ripple Thyme (Code: 5430)
 Light green, lemon-scented foliage creates a spreading evergreen carpet topped by pink flowers in summer. An excellent choice for pathways, between pavers, or in the rockery. (6" x 12") Zn5.



Thymus x citriodorus 'Archer's Gold'
Lemon Thyme (Code: 3602)
 Creeping thyme with brilliant golden, evergreen foliage that is especially bright in winter and spring. Excellent between pavers or spilling around stones. (2" x 12") Zn5.



Thymus x citriodorus 'Argentus'
Silver Variegated Lemon Thyme (Code: 8253)

Lemon Thyme (Code: 4160)

Thymus x citriodorus 'Lime Gold'
Thyme (Code: 7779)
 Creeping evergreen lime-gold foliage has a citrus fragrance. Pink flowers appear in summer. Excellent when used between flagstone or in the rock garden. (2-4" x 12-18") Zn5.



Thymus x citriodorus 'Lime'
Lime Thyme (Code: 3761)
 Bright chartreuse leaves brighten up any garden. It has a lovely citrus scent and pink flowers. A nice plant to border pathways or as an evergreen groundcover. (4" x 12-16") Zn5.



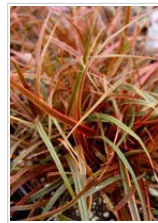
Thymus x citriodorus 'Spicy Orange'
Citrus-Scented Thyme (Code: 6896)
 This prostrate, needle-leaved thyme makes an excellent evergreen groundcover. Releasing a refreshing scent of oranges when crushed, it is perfect between pavers. (4" x 24") Zn5.



Tiarella 'Neon Lights'
Foam Flower (Code: 4852)
 Neon-green foliage has very black central markings topped by glowing large white flowers in spring. Leaves turn almost completely green in summer. (6-8" x 18-24") Zn4. PP13289, EU13669 Propagation Prohibited.



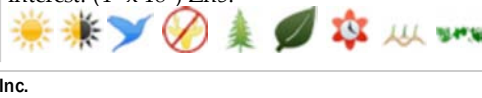
Uncinia rubra
Red Hook Sedge (Code: 4177)
 This evergreen New Zealand sedge displays rich, bronze-colored blades. A marvelous addition to any garden. It prefers a cool, moist site in sun or partial shade. (18" x 24") Zn8.



Uncinia rubra 'Belinda's Find'
Red Hook Sedge (Code: 7609)
 Rich cherry-red leaf margins brighten the colorful bronze foliage. Ideal as a specimen at the front of the perennial border. It's also especially useful to brighten autumn & winter containers. (12" x 12-16") Zn8.



Veronica 'Waterperry Blue'
Speedwell (Code: 7370)

Turkish Speedwell (Code: 3671)

Veronica peduncularis 'Georgia Blue'

Speedwell (Code: 6082)

Speedwell (Code: 4425)

Dainty flowers of palest blue last all spring. It forms a deep green, spreading evergreen mat. An excellent lawn substitute; it fills in fast and suppresses weeds. (1" x 18") Zn5.



Viburnum propinquum

Chinese Viburnum (Code: 6479)

Elegant compact shrub with evergreen, glossy dark green foliage. White summer flowers bloom on red stems and turn to metallic-blue berries in fall. (10-12' x 6') Zn7.



Vinca minor 'Bowle's Variety'

Periwinkle (Code: 3790)

Large, deep periwinkle-blue flowers top shiny green foliage in spring. This attractive, trouble-free, spreading evergreen groundcover can handle a variety of soils and conditions. (4-6" x 18-24") Zn4.



Vinca minor 'Illumination'

Periwinkle (Code: 7364)

In spring, periwinkle-blue flowers provide bold contrast to brilliant gold leaves edged in green. Use it as trailing foliage in mixed containers or as an evergreen groundcover. (4" x 18") Zn4. PP12132 Propagation Prohibited.



Vinca minor 'Ralph Shugert'

Periwinkle (Code: 6455)

Dark green foliage is edged with distinctive cream margins that set off bright blue flowers in spring. This is a marvelous evergreen groundcover. (4-6" x 18-24") Zn4. PP6960 Propagation Prohibited.



Waldsteinia fragarioides

Barren Strawberry (Code: 3714)

Sunny-yellow flowers are scattered over strawberry-like, evergreen foliage. A tough, mat-forming groundcover that tolerates a wide variety of conditions. (4" x 10") Zn3.



Yucca filamentosa 'Bright Edge'

Adam's Needle (Code: 4328)

Succulent green leaves have sunny-gold margins and form large, spiky, drought tolerant rosettes. Tall, dangling clusters of white blooms are dramatic and showy. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (4' x 3') Zn4. PPAF Propagation Prohibited



Yucca filamentosa 'Color Guard'

Adam's Needle (Code: 3247)

A brilliant gold stripe accentuates the center of each broad green leaf. At its best in late summer. Fragrant creamy-white flowers appear late spring above rose-blushed leaves. A "Great Plant Pick" for the Pacific Northwest! (3' x 3') Zn5.



Yucca gloriosa var. recurvifolia 'Bright Star'

Adam's Needle (Code: 6012)

Tri-colored, sword-like, evergreen foliage forms a rosette in shades of ivory, pink and green. Lavender flowers rise above the drought tolerant blades in summer. (36" x 36") Zn7. PP17653 Propagation Prohibited.



Yucca rostrata 'Sapphire Skies'

Yucca (Code: 7630)

Stunning long, powder-blue leaves quickly grow into a three-by-four-foot mound. With some age it will begin rising on a stout trunk to a height of four feet or more. At maturity, spectacular spires of ivory flowers appear in summer. The foliage is greener when young. Requires excellent drainage. (4-6' x 4-6') Zn6.
