








⁴ Plant hardiness map with zones







TREES

Acer circinatum – Acer palmatum



Acer circinatum 'Little Gem'

This dwarf vine maple forms a dense mound. Small green leaves emerge with a slight red tinge in the spring, and turn shades of orange and red in fall.

Vine Maple • Sun-Shade • 5 x 5' • Zone 5



Acer circinatum 'Pacific Fire'

This selection forms an open mound featuring light green foliage that takes on orange highlights in full sun. Brilliant red twigs are the highlight of this vine maple. Fall colors are especially striking with contrasting golden yellow and orange foliage.

Vine Maple • Part sun-Shade • 12x8' in 10 years • Zone 5



Acer circinatum 'Sunglow'

Leaves emerge with tones of peach and apricot while maintaining green veins. Foliage matures to a light green and fall colors take on shades of purple to red.

Vine Maple • Part shade • 6x3' in 10 years • Zone 5



Acer circinatum 'Sunny Sister'

This small, upright, deciduous tree is a great addition to any landscape. Leaves emerge orange-yellow, with pink highlights in full sun, maturing to light green. In fall, leaves change to bright yellow and orange.

Vine Maple • Sun-Part shade • 6x3' in 10 years • Zone 5



Acer japonicum 'Green Cascade'

A weeping form of japonicum, with more substantial leaves and more intense color than 'Viridis'. Medium green color turns a concentrated yellow-gold to crimson in fall.

Fernleaf Maple • Filtered sun • 4-5x8-10' • Zone 5



Acer japonicum 'Aconitifolium'

An upright tree with a bushy habit and large, rounded fern-like leaves. Rich green color turns scarlet in fall.

Fernleaf Maple • Sun-Part sun • 15 x 20' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum

The principal species to which most Japanese maple cultivars belong. An excellent upright form. Light green leaves turn shades of yellow, orange, and bronze-red in fall.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 20x 20' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Adrian's Compact'

A nice upright, compact tree, with small burgundy-red leaves. Fall color includes bright orange and red.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part shade • 10x6' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Beni hime'

A dwarf, shrubby tree with small, rounded star shaped leaves. New growth is pinkish red with red margins on green base. Remains both red and green through summer becoming more intensely red and purple in fall.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 3-5x4' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Bonfire'

A small upright tree with glossy leaves that emerge bright red and fade to green. Nice multicolor effect all summer, brilliant red in fall. Dense growth habit.

Japanese Maple • Full sun • 15x15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Arakawa', Rough Bark Maple

Arakawa is known as the rough bark maple because of its unique corky bark. The rough texture develops after several years and becomes quite prominent over time. Leaves are green with deeply palmate lobes. Fall color is fantastic, with leaves turning bright orange, gold and red. Protect young foliage from late spring frosts.

Rough Bark Maple • Filtered sun • 18x15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Bihou'

A small, upright deciduous tree with tiny yellow-green leaves. Fall color is yellow to orange. Bark on twigs and branches turns a vivid coral yellow with an orange overcast in winter. The Japanese name means "beautiful mountain range".

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part shade • 7x3' in 10 years • Zone 5



A vigorous, upright habit with blackish red new stems. Large deeply cut red leaves turn brighter red in fall. The iconic red upright Japanese maple to which all others are compared.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 20 x 20' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Butterfly'

Small tree with an upright form. Small green leaves are edged in white and soft pink margins that turn brighter pink in fall.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 12-15x 6' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Emperor I'

An upright maple, similar to 'Bloodgood', but with a faster growing rate. This cultivar has a narrower habit with dark red-purple leaves which turn scarlet in the fall. Ideal for colder climates.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 20 x 20' • Zone 5

Acer palmatum



Acer palmatum 'Fireglow'

Upright maple similar to 'Bloodgood', but on the smaller side with brighter red fall coloration. New leaves are slightly more pink than 'Bloodgood'.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 16 x 16' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Gable Glory'

Bright orange-red new leaf color is long lasting, especially in some shade, maturing to burgundy red. Unusual bark is yellowish orange and provides winter interest.

Japanese Maple • Part shade • 15x15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Geisha Gone Wild'

A small variegated form with narrow, purple-green foliage, is irregularly edged with pink and white. New growth is bright hot-pink while fall foliage changes to purple-orange, then red.

Japanese Maple • Part Shade • 6x3' • Zone 6



Acer palmatum 'Hime shojo'

An excellent dwarf red palmatum, growing dense but more upright than spreading. Flushes of red, deeply divided new leaves appear all season, maturing to a dark maroon; giving this treasure a contrasting color effect. Best color in full sun, although afternoon shade in hot climates is appreciated.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Light shade • 5x4' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Ilarian'

Small deciduous, upright tree with unusual tiny pink, green and white variegated leaves. Stunning foliage changes to a bright orange or red in fall.

 $\textit{Japanese Maple} \cdot \textit{Sun-Part shade} \cdot \textit{8x4'} \cdot \textit{Zone} \, 6$



Acer palmatum 'JN4', Dragon Tears™ PP22249

This palmate-leaved Japanese Maple cascades like a dissectum, but is not as wide. Its spring color is crimson red, turning burgundy red as the leaf matures for summer. By end of summer the color changes to rusty red. Autumn leaf color is bright red. This is a must for the collector. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.



Acer palmatum 'Katsura'

Beautiful bright yellow leaves with coral tones lasting into summer. Leaves fade to soft green before turning brilliant gold and orange in autumn. New branches turn vibrant coral-orange in winter.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part shade • 20x15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Kamagata', Eagle Claw

Small leaves with long angular lobes emerge with a red margin on a light green leaf. Mid-summer color is bright green before turning intense orange-yellow and red in fall. Has a soft appearance and a dense habit.

Japanese Maple • Full sun • 8-10x8-10' • Zone 5



This rounded tree has bright green, flat leaves with double serrations on the margins, giving it a distinctly tiered and lacey appearance. Fall color is yellow-gold with rose highlights.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 15-20x 12-15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Kiyohime'

Small, star-shaped leaves on a vigorous but dense, compact grower. Rich green leaves emerge with bright red-orange margins around yellow centers. Fall color is yellow-orange to bronze.

Japanese Maple • Full sun • 6x6' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Koto-no-ito', Harp String Maple

Meaning "Harp Strings", the name of this cultivar aptly describes this tree's very fine thread-like leaves. Foliage opens with a hint of crimson, quickly turning green. Fall color is bright yellow. Very graceful appearance.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 6-10x 6-8' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Lima Gold'

Tiny yellow-green, seven-lobed leaves adorn this dense dwarf maple. Fall color is a light golden yellow. Its compact stature makes it highly suitable for a container or small garden.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part sun • 3x3' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Manyo no sato'

Narrow, deeply divided leaves emerge purple and harden off to green and purple. In late summer purple leaves turn deep green, creating a two-tone green effect. Fall color is purple and orange.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part sun • 6 x 4' • Zone 5

Acer palmatum 'Mikawa yatsubusa'

Large, overlapping leaves make this maple quite unusual. Bright yellow-green new growth matures to rich green. Very striking dwarf tree.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Shade • 12x12' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Omato'

This upright, green maple has large, broadly ovate leaves with 5-7 lobes. Leaves emerge with a hint of orange-red, mature to rich green, then turn brilliant tones of red in fall.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part shade • 25x 25' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Orange Dream'

Similar to 'Katsura' but even more colorful. A nicely branched upright tree, the large leaves begin coral-orange and progress to vibrant yellow with red undertones, eventually maturing to a soft green. Bright gold and coral in fall.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 25 x 15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Oregon Sunset'

Large leaves round out the overall globed-shape of this compact grower. Purple-red leaves begin as a soft red in spring. In fall, the leaves turn an outstanding orange-red.

Acer palmatum 'Peaches and Cream'

Spring foliage emerges cream with green highlights and rose-red tips. Deep green veins create a variegated appearance. Fall color is yellow with dark tips.

Japanese Maple • Part shade • 10 x 10' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Peridot Flame'

A dwarf Japanese maple that briefly emerges red and turns bronze-green. Deeply lobed and serrated leaf edges mimic a flame. Fall tones are yellow and orange.

Acer palmatum 'Purple Ghost'

Purple-red foliage with dark black veins turning bright red to orange in fall. The more sun, the darker the leaves.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 15-18x 15-18' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Rhode Island Red'

This compact, red-leaved maple forms a broad dome-shaped crown. Bright red leaves mature to burgundy-red, finally turning orange to red in fall. Dark red stems provide winter interest.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part shade • 6x6' in 10 years • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Sango kaku', Coral Bark

'Sango kaku' is known for its magnificent coral-pink bark in the winter. An upright grower with mediumsized, light green leaves until fall, when they become an apricot-orange followed by a brilliant gold. Very showy tree with a nice upright form.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 20-25 x 18-20' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Sharp's Pygmy'

A dwarf tree with very compact growth. Small, serrated, green leaves turn brilliant yellow and scarlet-orange in autumn.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 3-4x3-4' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Shaina'

A popular compact, upright, and densely branching tree. Small, deeply cut leaves remain close to the branches. Leaves begin a bright red and mature to a deep reddish purple and magenta in fall.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 5-8x4-8' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Shishigashira', Lion's Head

Small, bright green leaves curl tightly against branches. Densely packed leaves create a striking appearance on this slow growing, compact, upright tree which turns brilliant gold with some red and pink shades in autumn.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 15-20 x 15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Skeeter's Broom'

New growth on this compact Japanese Maple emerges a lovely bright red. As the foliage matures it takes on more of a burgundy color.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 6x6 in 10 years • Zone 5

Acer palmatum - Acer palmatum dissectum



Acer palmatum 'Taylor' PP15943

This dwarf shrub maple is known for its stunning pink new growth. In late spring leaf centers turn green while margins remain pink. The leaves turn lime green in the fall before they drop. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part shade • 4x3' in 10 years • Zone 6



Acer palmatum 'Twombly's Red Sentinel'

This compact and narrow growing tree has lovely deep maroon foliage. The color holds well throughout the hot summer months, and becomes a beautiful crimson in autumn.

Japanese Maple • Filtered sun • 6 x 3' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Tobiosho'

Known for its brilliant red fall color, 'Tobiosho' has an upright, rounded habit and bears medium green leaves through spring and summer. Fall color is scarlet red.

 $\textit{Japanese Maple} \bullet \textit{Filtered sun} \bullet \textit{15-20x10-15'} \bullet \textit{Zone 5}$



Acer palmatum 'Wakehurst Pink'

This upright, open-branched tree has deeply lobed leaves that emerge pink, and mature to green with erratic pink and white variegation. Fall brings a stunning display of vibrant red leaves with yellow tips.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Part shade • 13x13' in15 years • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Tsuma gaki'

Light green leaves, with reddish lobe-tips, turn crimson red in the fall. Small, rounded, upright tree.

Japanese Maple • Shade • 6-10x6-10' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum 'Ukigumo', Floating Cloud

A very small ornamental tree. Leaves are mixed green, white, and pink with variegation changing throughout the season.

Japanese Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 12x8' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Baby Lace'

Small very finely dissected leaves emerge a pinkish red fading to a bronze-green. Fall color is more reddish with hints of pink and orange. A delicate looking maple as leaves have an airy, spider-like appearance. Remains quite dwarf.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Baldsmith'

A mounding laceleaf with finely cut leaves. Spring color is bright orange-red, fading to soft green in summer, finally turning brilliant orange in fall.

Laceleaf Maple • Filtered sun • 5x6' in 10 years • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Crimson Queen'

A lovely laceleaf maple with deep purple-red color and a nice cascading habit. Holds color well in heat and turns deep scarlet in fall.

 $\textit{Laceleaf Maple} \cdot \textit{Filtered sun} \cdot \textit{6-8x10-12'} \cdot \textit{Zone 5}$



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Filigree'

Lacy green, very serrated leaves begin pale and darken as the season progresses. Fall color is yellow to orange. Horizontal branching habit is very pendulous.

Laceleaf Maple • Filtered sun • 3-6 x 4-8' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Inaba shidare'

Rich maroon laceleaf with a cascading habit that is a bit more upright than most. Crimson in fall. Faster growing than other red laceleafs.

Laceleaf Maple • Sun-Filtered sun • 7x10' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Jeddeloh Orange'

Finely dissected leaves have strong red-orange margins and pale green centers. Fall color is intense red. A lovely small specimen tree.

Laceleaf Maple • Sun-Part sun • 5x6' • Zone 5

TREES

Acer palmatum dissectum - Cercis canadensis



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Lemon Lime Lace'

Lace-like leaves emerge yellow, maturing to lime green, giving this weeping Japanese maple a lovely two-toned appearance. Fall color ranges from yellow to orange.

Laceleaf Maple • Sun-Part shade • 4x9' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Red Dragon'

A beautiful weeping laceleaf with new red leaves which mature to purple-red. This cultivar holds deep red color in sun or shade, better than any other red dissectum. Rich red in fall.

Laceleaf Maple • Filtered sun-Shade • 7x 10' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Orangeola'

Leaves emerge an orange-red then fade to dark red. Heavy shade encourages a deep green cast. It is a beautiful effect enhanced by leaves that are a bit more glossy than most of the reddish purple varieties of laceleaf. Bright redorange in autumn in a long lasting vibrant display. Dense branches cascade nicely.

Acer palmatum dissectum 'Red Filigree Lace'

Extremely lacy, deep purple uniform color, with deep purple to red fall color. One of the most unusual laceleafs available.

 $\textit{Laceleaf Maple} \cdot \textit{Filtered sun} \cdot \textit{5x5'} \cdot \textit{Zone 5}$



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Seiryu'

A very attractive upright growth form with small, lacy green leaves until autumn, when leaves turn red and gold with tones of purple. A very attractive and unusual upright.

Laceleaf Maple • Filtered sun • 25x15' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Tamuke yama'

A rich red-purple laceleaf which holds its color well through summer. Leaves emerge slightly more red; fall color is brilliant red. Grows quickly to maturity.

Laceleaf Maple • Filtered sun • 6-8x8-12 '• Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Viridis'

The most common green laceleaf maple. Bright green leaves turn yellow-gold with hints of orange and red in fall. Cascading habit.

Laceleaf Maple • Filtered sun-Part shade • 6-10x8-10' • Zone 5



Acer palmatum dissectum 'Waterfall'

Small, deciduous tree that has strongly cascading branches. Green foliage turns gold with traces of orange and scarlet in the fall.

Laceleaf Maple • Full sun • 4-6x8-12' • Zone 5



Acer shirasawanum 'Autumn Moon'

Small, deciduous tree. Leaves have many more lobes than a palmatum, giving the leaves a rounded appearance. Foliage is burnt orange in sun; yellow in shade; and rose-orange in the fall.

Fullmoon Maple • Part sun-Part shade • 20 x 15' • Zone 5



Acer pseudoplatanus 'Eskimo Sunset'

A stunning maple! Its spring leaves emerge orangepink and settle into a leaf that is green, splashed with cream and pink coloring. The underside of the leaf is purple!

Sycamore Maple • Sun-Light shade • 30 x 20' • Zone 4



Cercidiphyllum japonicum 'Red Fox'

Smokey purple leaves slowly fade to green-bronze. In fall, crushed leaves smell like burnt sugar. Compact vase-shaped tree.

Katsura Tree • Sun-Part shade • 40x25' • Zone 4



Acer shirasawanum 'Aureum'

Beautiful tree with bright yellow leaves that turn orange-red in fall. Leaves have many more lobes than a palmatum, giving the leaves a rounded appearance. In shade, the leaves will be more chartreuse. Upright and bushy growth habit.

Fullmoon Maple • Part sun-Part shade • 15-20x 15-20' • Zone 5



Arbutus unedo 'Compacta'

White urn-shaped flowers bloom in late summer followed by strawberry-like red fruit persisting into winter. Attractive flaky, red-brown bark. Compact growth habit.

Compact Strawberry Tree • Sun-Part shade • 10 x 10' • Zone 7



Cercis canadensis 'Covey', Lavender Twist®

This redbud is a tough tree whose branches arch and weep elegantly. In spring the branches are covered with lavender-pink flowers and later, with heart-shaped leaves that are slightly larger than found in other redbuds. Autumn foliage is bright yellow.

Eastern Redbud • Sun-Part shade • 6x8' • Zone 5

TREES

Cercis canadensis – Ginkgo biloba



Cercis canadensis 'Greswan', Burgundy Hearts® PP19654

This redbud has fuchsia pea-like flowers along the branches from early to mid-spring before the leaves appear. It has attractive burgundy foliage which emerges brick-red in spring. The heart-shaped leaves turn yellow in fall. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Eastern Redbud • Sun-Part sun • 20x25' • Zone 5



Cercis canadensis 'Ruby Falls' PP22097

A weeping redbud with large purple leaves. Redpurple flowers bloom on bare stems in early spring. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Eastern Redbud • Full sun • 6-8x 10-12' • Zone 4



Cornus kousa 'Schmred', Heart Throb®

Large rosy pink flower bracts adorn this deciduous tree for up to 2 months. Dark attractive green leaves will turn deep red in fall. Red fruit attract birds.

Dogwood • Sun-Part shade • 20 x 20' • Zone 5



Cornus kousa 'Summer Fun'

An impressive new white variegated kousa dogwood. In spring, each leaf emerges with a stunning pink-white margin, and displays showy fall color.

Dogwood • Sun-Part shade • 18x15' • Zone 5



Cornus x 'KF111-1', Hyperion® PP22219

A very fast growing specimen with large, showy white flowers, and red berries. Yellow, purple and orange fall color. Resistant to disease and drought. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Dogwood • Sun-Part shade • 25x25' • Zone 6



Cornus kousa 'Summer Gold' PP22765

White flower bracts. Green leaves have yellow margins that turn soft pink in summer. Flaming red fall color. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited.*

Dogwood • Part shade • 15 x 15' • Zone 5



Cornus x 'KN30-8', Venus® PP16309

Deciduous tree with showy white, 6" flowers, followed by bright, shiny red fruit. Dark green foliage turns orange in the fall. Highly disease resistant! *Unlicensed propagation prohibited.*

Dogwood • Sun-Part shade • 25x25' • Zone 5



Fagus sylvatica 'Tricolor'

A beautiful tree with very interesting foliage. The slightly serrated leaves have a base color of deep purple which is surrounded by a broad irregular margin that has pinkish white and rose colors.

Beech · Part shade · 30x20' · Zone 4



Ginkgo biloba 'Autumn Gold'

This male cultivar of Ginkgo is practically pest-free and resistant to storm damage. The shape is often irregular with a large branch or two seemingly forming its own tree on the trunk. Unique fan-shaped green foliage turns golden yellow in fall; however, leaves fall quickly and the fall show is short.



Fagus sylvatica 'Purple Fountain'

A fascinating tree which has an overall upright shape, with lateral branches that cascade down to the ground, giving it an elegant and interesting look. The glossy, green-purple leaves take on a lovely bronze color during the fall season.

Pinus nigra 'Green Tower'

If you want an ideal specimen for a smaller space, this is it. A strongly fastigiate habit is softened by lush, long, dark green needles. The sturdy branching withstands snow and ice well.

Pinus x schwerinii 'Wiethorst'

Pinus strobus 'Blue Shag'

This unique, dwarf pine is dense with long 5" bluegreen needles softening the look of this rounded conifer. Bears numerous gray to blue cones, even when young.

This dwarf White Pine with twisted, curly green needles will add texture and interest to any garden. This compact grower originated as a witch's broom.

An evergreen with an upright growth habit that makes it much more suitable for smaller spaces than other White Pines. Soft blue-green needles look great when mixed with other conifers.

Globe shaped when young, this conifer eventually becomes loosely pyramidal. Long, thin needles emerge golden, fading to a soft yellow-green during winter.

Dwarf, compact, evergreen shrub with rounded habit has short, lime-green needles. Does not produce cones.

Taxus baccata 'Fastigiata', Irish Yew

The deep green, soft needles on this columnar growing evergreen add a nice touch of both color and texture to the landscape. Perfect for vertical accents due to its upright growth habit.

Pinus thunbergii 'Kotobuki'

Short, dark green needles, with branches that grow upward and form a tight and narrow habit.

Dwarf evergreen shrub with glossy, dark green needles and large white candles. Forms a broad, dense pyramid.

Sciadopitys verticillata

This slow growing tree is used for its unusual texture and growth habit. On young plants the branches stick straight out from the single, straight trunk but become more pendulous with age. Taxus baccata 'Repandens'

Medium green foliage on narrow, columnar evergreen shrub, has purple tint in winter. Protect from strong winds.

A slow growing compact globe-shaped shrub with rich bluish-green foliage that bronzes in winter.

Thuja occidentalis 'Janed Gold', Highlights™ PP21967

Thuja occidentalis 'Smaragd'

Compact, columnar evergreen shrub has feathery, rich green foliage that holds its color all year.

Thuja occidentalis 'Tom Thumb'

Unique golden, thread-like foliage grows upright creating a tear drop effect on this dwarf conifer. Winter foliage turns orange-bronze, adding both color and texture to the landscape year-round.

Thuja plicata 'Daniellow', Golden Spire PP20267

Year-round bright yellow foliage glows on this tightly upright conifer. Best color when grown in full sun. Unlicensed propagation prohibited.

Thuja plicata 'De Rakt', Sugar and Spice PP19926

Soft textured evergreen with fine foliage, very slender and vertical growing. Perfect for smaller gardens and container planting. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Western Red Cedar • Sun-Part shade • 8-10' in 10 years • Zone 5



Thuja plicata '4EVER', Forever Goldy PP19267

Year-round interest is what you get with this upright conifer. Its golden color and sculptural form are stunning. Red stems and an orange tint to the foliage appear in fall and winter. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Western Red Cedar • Sun-Part shade • 20x5' • Zone 5



Thuja plicata 'Excelsa'

This versatile evergreen can be used as a specimen, screen or sheared as a hedge. Pyramidal growth habit, with glossy green foliage in winter. Deer resistant and drought tolerant.

Western Red Cedar • Sun-Part shade • 35x15' • Zone 4



Thuja plicata 'Whipcord'

An interesting evergreen with foliage that is thin and cord-like, arching from the center of the plant. Makes a great focal point in the landscape.

Western Red Cedar • Full sun • 5x5' • Zone 5



Thuja plicata 'Green Giant'

An excellent substitute for Leyland Cypress, this evergreen has a nice upright conical shape that requires no pruning. Ideal for screens and can be sheared for hedges. Disease and deer resistant.

Western Red Cedar • Sun-Part shade • 60 x 18' • Zone 5



Thuja plicata x standishii 'BFC68', Virginian PP2668

A densely foliaged evergreen conifer with a soft feathery texture. Conical and upright, its habit is small and heavily branched with deep green leaves. Tolerates heat, humidity, and cold. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited.*

Western Red Cedar • Sun-Part shade • 14x6' in 10 years • Zone 5



Thuja plicata 'Virescens'

This evergreen has a narrow habit, making it ideal for smaller spaces. The foliage is a lovely deep green which holds well throughout the year. A hardy and reliable choice.

Western Red Cedar • Sun-Part shade • 30x12' • Zone 5



Thujopsis dolabrata

A seedling selected for its slow, compact growth habit, expect 4-6" of new growth per year. Scale-like, foliage is glossy, green and fragrant. Flattened sprays are held horizontally, showing the silvery undersides. Bark is red-brown and scented.

Ferns



Athyrium filix-femina

Light green feathery fronds add great color and texture to the landscape. Fronds are arrowhead-shaped, up to 1' wide and 3' long. This deciduous fern grows in thick, rounded clumps.

Lady Fern • Part shade-Shade • 3 x 2.5'• Zone 4



Athyrium niponicum var. pictum

Deciduous, arching, blue-green fronds with silvergray and reddish variegation. Good in woodland gardens, mass plantings, containers, and borders. Needs good air circulation.

Japanese Painted Fern • Filtered sun-Shade • 2x1' • Zone 4



Athyrium niponicum var. pictum 'Regal Red'

A stunning addition to the shade garden, this deciduous fern has silvery green fronds with violet-red highlights. Excellent for cutting. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Japanese Painted Fern • Part shade-Shade • 1.5x2'• Zone 4



Cyrtomium fortunei

An evergreen fern with matte green fronds that are similar to holly branches. Stiff upright clumps add texture and interest to the garden.

Holly Fern • Part shade-Shade • 2-3x2'• Zone 6



Dryopteris erythrosora 'Brilliance™'

Young fronds are lustrous, displaying orange, copper, and pink colors that intensify the landscape.

Autumn Fern • Part shade-Shade • 1.5x2' • Zone 5



Dryopteris marginalis

A fantastic addition to woodland gardens, this clumping fern has deeply cut, blue-green fronds. Evergreen and cold tolerant.

Marginal Wood Fern • Part shade - Shade • 2x2' • Zone 3



Matteuccia struthiopteris

The light to medium green fronds of this beautiful and elegant fern are upright and slightly arching. Their size and texture lend a tropical air wherever they are planted. The young fiddleheads are edible.

Ostrich Fern • Part shade - Shade • 4x3' • Zone 3



Polystichum munitum

A great structural, evergreen fern growing from a dense, slowly expanding crown.

Western Sword Fern • Part shade-Shade • 4x7' • Zone 5



Polystichum setiferum 'Divisilobum'

Semi-evergreen with delicately dissected foliage. Arching fronds create a very lacy appearance.

Soft Shield Fern • Part shade-Shade • 2x2' Zone 6

Grasses



Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Eldorado' PP16486

This cool-season, ornamental grass is green with golden yellow centers along the leaf blades. Inflorescences develop in early summer, rising above the foliage, and are variable in height, giving this clumping grass a more informal appearance. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Feather Reed Grass • Full sun-Part shade • 4x 2.5' • Zone 5



Carex albula 'Frosty Curls'

A clumping evergreen sedge with very fine frosty colored leaves. 'Frosty Curls' adds texture to the landscape. Tolerates both dry and wet sites.

Sedge • Sun-Part shade • 1.5 x 1.5' • Zone 6



Carex oshimensis 'Carfit01', EverColor® Everest PP20955

An evergreen, variegated sedge with green centers and bright white edges. Neat grass-like leaves rise from the crown and arch gracefully to create a stunning effect. Useful in containers, borders, or to brighten up a shady garden. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Sedge • Part sun-Shade • 18x18" • Zone 5



Calamagrostis x acutiflora 'Karl Foerster'

This is a cool season, clumping grass with a compact, erect growth habit. Magnificent, wheat-like seed heads appear in late spring and last all season long. This tall grass provides a great backdrop for lower growing plants, is useful for screening, and will not reseed. A good choice for heavy clay soils.



Carex testacea

This orange New Zealand sage has bronze green, arching leaves becoming vivid orange in fall. Foliage provides multi-season interest. Deer and rabbit resistant.

Sedge • Sun-Part shade • 2x2' • Zone 6



Festuca glauca 'Casca11', Beyond Blue™ PP23307

From spring through winter this outstanding fescue carries its rich steel blue color throughout. Growing in a mound, the fine foliage cascades neatly, and the inflorescences rise 6-8" above the foliage. Tolerates heat, humidity, and drought. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Blue Fescue • Sun-Part sun • 12x 18" • Zone 4



Hakonechloa macra 'All Gold'

Shiny, pure golden leaves arch gracefully. Slow to establish. Good in shady and woodland gardens.

Japanese Forest Grass • Part shade • 14x18" • Zone 5



Hakonechloa macra 'Aureola'

Green and gold striped foliage arches gracefully. Slow to establish, but worth the wait.

Japanese Forest Grass • *Part shade* • 18 x 18" • Zone 5



Hakonechloa macra 'Beni-kaze'

Graceful ribbon-like leaves that are green in summer turn brilliant shades of red in the fall. Clumping, spreading habit. Easy to grow.

Japanese Forest Grass • Part sun-Part shade • 12-18x18-24" • Zone 5



Hakonechloa macra 'Nicolas' PP19898

This clumping grass has green foliage in spring and summer with orange and red tones in fall. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Japanese Forest Grass • Part shade • 8-16 x 18-24" • Zone 5



Muhlenbergia capillaris

For late summer interest, you can't beat this ornamental grass. Flower stalks form clouds of pink plumes which hover 1' above the foliage. Tolerates heat and humidity.


Muhly Grass • Sun-Part shade • 2x2' Zone 6



Muhlenbergia reverchonii 'Pund01s', Undaunted®

Gray-green rounded clumps of foliage are topped by 1' tall red flower spikes in fall, persisting into winter. Nice in mass plantings or as a specimen. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Ruby Muhly • Full Sun • 18 x 24" • Zone 5



Ophiopogon planiscapus 'Nigrescens'

This semi-evergreen has purple-black grass-like leaves which form a slowly spreading clump. Small bell-shaped light pink flowers produce glossy dark purple berries.

Black Mondo Grass • Sun-Part shade • 1x1' • Zone 6



Panicum virgatum 'Red Sunset' PPAF

An attractive ornamental grass for the landscape. Blue-green leaves and stems emerge in spring quickly maturing to wine red by early summer. Beginning in late summer, clumps are topped with airy, rosy red panicles. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Switch Grass • Sun-Part sun • 3-4x3-4' • Zone 4



Miscanthus sinensis 'Little Miss' PP28849

A compact, clumping grass with narrow, arching foliage emerges green in spring, and develops blades tipped in crimson and purple tones. This two-tone effect intensifies as the season progresses. Red flowers rise above the foliage, producing showy buff colored seed heads late in summer, persisting through fall. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Maiden Grass• 2-3x 2-3' • Sun-Part shade • Zone 4



Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Burgundy Bunny' PP21917

A dwarf fountain grass forming an upright clump of narrow green leaves. Red highlights begin in late spring and by fall the foliage is completely ablaze. Small tufts of cream colored flower plumes appear a few inches above the foliage in late summer. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited*.

Fountain Grass • Sun-Part shade • 1 x 1' • Zone 6

PERENNIALS

Grasses - Hosta - Yucca



Pennisetum alopecuroides 'Piglet' PP19074

A spreading clump of narrow green leaves, fall color is red-brown. Silvery to pinkish white flower spikes arch gracefully upward above the foliage. Grows well in moist conditions, but tolerates drought once established. *Unlicensed propagation prohibited.*

Fountain Grass • Sun-Part sun • 18 x 24" • Zone 5



Hosta 'Blue Angel'

Large, textured blue leaves with pale lavender to white flower spikes.

Plantain Lily • Part shade-Shade • 36x48" • Zone 3



Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears'

Small, rounded leaves give this hardy, clump-forming Hosta its name. Short stalks of lavender flowers stand above blue-green to gray-green foliage.

Plantain Lily • Part shade-Shade • 7 x 12" • Zone 3



Hosta 'Fire and Ice'

Twisted leaves and variegation give this herbaceous perennial an interesting wavy look. Foliage has white centers and irregular dark green margins. Pale lavender flowers bloom in summer.

Plantain Lily • Part shade-Shade • 16 x 32" • Zone 3



Hosta 'Great Expectations'

Large leaves with gold centers turn creamy white with blue-green margins.

Plantain Lily • Part shade • 24x36" • Zone 3



Hosta 'Guacamole'

This large leaved Hosta also has large, fragrant, white flowers. Foliage is rich green with chartreuse centers.

Plantain Lily • Part shade-Shade • 18x36" • Zone 3



Hosta 'Patriot'

Dark green leaves with wide white edges. Lavender flowers. Blooms July to August.

Plantain Lily • Part shade-Shade • 24x36" • Zone3



Hosta 'Sum and Substance'

Huge, glossy, textured leaves are chartreuse to gold bearing pale lavender flowers.

Plantain Lily • Sun-Part shade • 30x60" • Zone 3



Hosta 'Stained Glass'

Large textured leaves are bright gold with irregular dark green margins. Heavy veins create a "stained glass" look. Pale lavender flowers are fragrant, blooming in late summer.

Plantain Lily • Part shade - Shade • 15x32" • Zone 3



Hosta tardiana 'June'

A striking Hosta, with foliage that has bold golden centers, surrounded by a wide margin of blue-green. Pale lavender summer blossoms round out the appeal.

Plantain Lily • Part shade-Shade • 12x30" • Zone 3



Yucca filamentosa 'Golden Sword'

Sword-like leaves have green margins and golden yellow centers. Spikes of white bell-shaped flowers rise 2 feet above the foliage.

Yucca • Full sun • 4x5' • Zone 4



Yucca rigida 'Blue Sentry'

As it ages, this yucca forms a trunk. Striking blue needles eventually become a powder blue in color. At maturity, a spectacular creamy white flowering stalk rises above the foliage. Drought resistant once established, it benefits from occasional watering during summer.
