


LOCATION MAP










SKYBRIDGE NECESSITY

- 1. Crucial link to utilities/redundancies in the garage
- 2. No additional room in alley for utilities
- 3. Connection to parking (no parking underneath Westin Building)
- 4. ADA access route to/from parking for building
- 5. Protected route for sensitive equipment
- 6. Building accessed 24/7
- 7. Secure access for Governor and others




EXISTING PEDESTRIAN ROUTE WITH SKYBRIDGE



- Pedestrian Route With Skybridge ~100'
- ADA Accessible Route With Skybridge ~100'

- Pedestrian Route Without Skybridge ~200'
- ■ ADA Accessible Route Without Skybridge ~500'
- * ADA accessible route would lengthen considerably (~ 400') without skybridge












PREVIOUS PUBLIC BENEFIT PACKAGE

Comments from 2/27/13 Design Commission Presentation:


- 1. Revise the public benefit package

- Focus improvements on 6th Ave and Virginia St










PUBLIC BENEFITS/AMENITIES - Architectural Canopies



Existing Conditions Sidewalk Width: 18'-6"



Location Map

- 8' & 6' wide aluminum & glass canopy
- 270 linear ft
- Installed height: 22'
- Character similar to those installed at 2020 Fifth Avenue
- Not to interfere with growth of Maple trees on site






PUBLIC BENEFITS/AMENITIES - Extended Tree/Planting Pits



- 4' X 4' tree pits extended to 4' X 8'
- Metal landscape planting guard to be used [similar to Via 6]
- Proposed Plants:
 - Sweetbox
 - Heuchera
 - Liriope
- 96 additional sq ft of planting

- Architectural canopy 6' in width on Virginia St to accommodate maple tree canopies








